JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed Hizma checkpoint located at the east entrance of Jerusalem and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the afternoon of June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya, detained a residents after assaulting him. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma then stormed and searched a home. (iii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Shu’fat camp and detained a resident. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and , Al-Eizariya and Al-Sawahira, clashed with several residents as the stormed 2 mosques , several homes , merchant shops and Al-Quds University (for the 2nd consecutive day) and stormed a school in Abu Dis and converted it into a military post, detained 10 residents then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces detained Maher Mubarak (A University student). (ii) Israeli forces detained Majdi Mahmoud in Al-Isawiya. (iii) Israeli forces detained Muti’ Zayed in Shu’fat camp. (iv) Israeli forces detained 10 residents: Mohammad Rab’I (17 years old), Omran Halibeh, Omar Rab’I, Daoud Badr, Hani Halibeh, Ali Abu Zayed, Jamil Abu Zaid, Musa Far’oun, Ahmad Ayad and Mahmoud Jafal in Abu Dis and , Al-Eizariya and Al-Sawahira, • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:30 and again at 19:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of June 22nd 2014, Israeli settler stormed Beit Hanina and slashed the tires of 3 vehicles and wrote racist graffiti. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya with cement blocks and dirt mounds.

(iv) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ni'meh village, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 02:30. (v) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, searched a local cemetery then withdrew at 03:05. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (ii) At 18:50 Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli settlers positioned at "Bet El" settlement set fire to a plot of land near Al-Jalazoun camp during which Palestinian Civil defence forces were able to extinguish the flames. (ii) At 17:045, Israeli settlers positioned at "Pesigout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh stoned several residents participating in the funeral of Mohammad Ismail (who was killed by Israeli forces in Ramallah as mentioned in the previous report) during which Israeli settlers guards opened fire towards the funeral participants and injured Osama Ahmad Al-Taweel. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli settlers positioned near "Nihalin" settlement opened fire towards 9 residents including a child as they were heading towards Al-Mazra'a Al-Sharqiya for work. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Faqou'a and detained a resident. (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Mugheir village until 17:30. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 23:30. (iv) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village, clashed with its residents as they stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:20. (v) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with its residents as they stormed and searched several homes and a print shop and confiscated a computer owned by Mohammad Abu Sayf. (vi) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Meithalun, stormed and searched 3 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00. (vii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:30. (viii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp, clashed with its residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes then withdrew at 05:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Milad Ma'ad in Faqou'a village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hussein Zaghhal in Zubaba village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Jihad Na'irat in Maythaloun. • <u>Injury:</u> At 02:00 on June 22nd 2014, Eyad Saba'neh was injured during confrontations with Israeli forces in Qabatiya village leaving him hospitalised with contusions as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Qabatiya village temporarily detained 4 women including 2 girls: Hanin Aghabriya (15 years old), Navin Aghabriya (17 years old), Du'a Aghabriya and Fathiyeh Aghabriya then released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tubas, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes then withdrew at 04:15.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u>, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Quffin until 15:00. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and its camps, clashed with several residents in the camp, detained a resident after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 05:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abdel Ra'uf in Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Jit village, temporarily detained Majdi Sufan then released him at a later time • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiya village, detained a resident then withdrew at 12:00. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Sanniriya village and detained a resident. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 00:25 (iv) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya and clashed with its residents. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qalqiliya, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children near Al-Shariqa school for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u>

(ii) Israeli forces detained Qeish Darwish in Sinariya village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 14:00, Mahmoud Al-Aqra' suffered a broken foot after falling while being apprehended by Israeli forces near the wall gate in Habalah leaving him hospitalised. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwar checkpoint , impeded the free flow of traffic and again at 11:20, closed the checkpoint then reopened it at 16:20 • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction, temporarily seized a Preventive Security force vehicle then allowed it to pass through at 11:30. (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 13:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Asqar camp, set up a checkpoint at Al-Quds road in the city, temporarily detained 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Amer (17 years old) and Ahmad Khalil then released them at a later time then clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and detained 3 residents then withdrew at 03:50 until 23:30. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Kafil Kalil village, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:50. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 03:50. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Taha Al-Salou', Abdel Rahaman Al-Bishtawi and Ahmad Al-Tanour in Nablus. (ii) Israeli forces detained Salah Amer in Kafr Qalil village • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 01:20 on June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces confiscated a

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bruqin until 18:30. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Al-Dik until 20:30. (iii) At 19:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Deir Ballut junction until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 11:40. (v) At 01:30, Israeli force raided Qarwat Bani Hassan, stormed and searched several homes until 04:15. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Ismail Al-Hindi, a resident of Kafr Qalil in Qalqiliya • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces declared the Dead Sea area as a closed Military area {After announcing that 3 Israeli Settlers went missing in the Hebron area} • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 12:10. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jiftlik village junction. (iii) At 20:35, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village junction in north Jericho until 21:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, searched a home then withdrew at 23:30. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and an Orphanage confiscated 4 computers and several files then withdrew at 03:15.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:40 on June 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Beit Jallah with steal gates.
- (x) At 18:40, Israeli forces closed all entrances and by pass roads leading to the main road din Al-Ubeidiya, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning then positioned near a National Security forces Checkpoint then withdrew at 19:50.
- **Checkpoint:** At 07:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Container checkpoint, prevented residents aged between 16 and 50 years old from entering through the checkpoint except for International Employees.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 12:00 and 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Nashash junction located in south Bethlehem.
 - (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Husan until 15:00.
 - (iii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 21:15.
 - (iv) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 21:30.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 15:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Jub'a village and mapped out a plot of land with several Police dogs then withdrew at 16:45.
