# At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. **ALL** Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by firing artillery shells from their **DISTRICTS** positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza and Rafah. Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement after launching 6 missiles towards North Gaza and Gaza leaving 2 Palestinian gunmen killed and injured 17 residents including a child. Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
