JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained 2 children. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal area in Abu Dis opened fire and fired stun grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 children: Yazan Al-Zur (17 years old) and Mustafa Al-Dik (17 years old) in Al-Ram. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 24th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya and detained a resident. (ii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, Al-Berih cities and Al-Amari camp in Al-Berih, stormed merchant storage room, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:00. (iii) At 05:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash’al village and stormed a home and a coffee shop. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ma’in Mafarja in Beit Liqya. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ibrahim Tumaleh, Amin Tumaleh and Mohammad Safi in Al-Amari camp in Al-Berih city. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Arana village until 13:00. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at ‘Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Quffin and detained a resident. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 04:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Osama Ta’ma in Quffin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed and searched a merchant shop and 2 apartment buildings, temporarily detained its residents, fired tear gas and flash grenades towards residents and as a result injured Yusef Abu Hamad a National Security officer, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ala Badrin, Arafat Thiyab and Murad Thiyab in Qalqiliya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:15, Israeli settlers stormed Immatin village and damaged 5 Olive tree owned by Ziyad Sawan. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ‘ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic and closed the check point at 06:55 then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 06:55, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints in Nablus, Deir Sharaf junction and north Huwara until 07:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus , Balata camp and Kafr Qalil village, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes and as a result suffocated 2 children from tear gas inhalation in Balata camp and injured Sadam Thiyab who broke his arm after falling as he was being apprehended by Israeli forces, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Thiyab Mansour, Jum’a Obada, Zahar Mansour and Nihad Mansour in Balata camp. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:25, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Yanoun, installed several tents, damaged several olive tree limbs and then withdrew at 15:50.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 06:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yasuf village until 10:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured Aysha Salim and served summons to 2 residents: Mohammad Asfour and Abdelrahman Shahin to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces closed Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 near Al-Nuw'meh village until 11:10. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho, stormed a home, temporarily detained its residents and released them at a later time then withdrew 02:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Mashrou' area in Beit Sahour, stormed a

	<p>home then withdrew at 05:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 24th 2013, Israeli forces raided Surif village and detained a resident. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron. (iii) At 16:00 and again at 23:45, Israeli forces raided Khursa village and stormed the South Electrical company. (iv) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:45. (v) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Halhoul while escorting several Israeli settlers and clashed with its residents. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces paved a road and levelled land in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood on the old city of Hebron for the purpose of settlement construction. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of June 24th 2013, Israeli settlers assaulted several sheppards as they were herding their sheep in Yatta during which Israeli forces detained 2 residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli force detained Ibrahim Abu Al-Rish in Surif village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaldoun Al-Tal in Al-Thahriya. (iii) Israeli forces detained Nassar Abu Humied (17 years old) and Ahmad

	<p style="text-align: center;">Abu Humied in Yatta.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis and Rafah.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of June 24th 2013, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Khan Yunis.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> On June 24th 2013, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green line towards agricultural land in Rafah.
