(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic and at 04:15 closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until a later time. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Qalandiya camp until 15:45. (ii) On June 25th 2014, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints around the walls of the old city of Jerusalem • Raid: At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 10:00. • Detention: At 23:50, Israeli forces detained Bassam Idris in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • Killing: At 12:30, Mustafa Aslan (A resident of Qalandiya camp) died of serious injuries sustained during clashed with Israeli forces in Qalandiya camp as mentioned in the June 20th 2014 Report. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Hata gate (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound) fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Assault on Property: At 19:00, Israeli forces stormed “The Arab Children” school in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood and closed down the school. • Confiscation of Property: On the evening of June 24th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Ras Khamis neighbourhood in Jerusalem and confiscated surveillance footage from merchant shop owned by Fadi Al-Sa’iri. • Assault on Places of Worship: At 07:00 on June 25th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers during which Israeli Police assaulted several religious students and worshipers near “Al-Marwani” and “Bab Al-Rahma Gates as they attempted to prevent the settler attack. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 17:40 on June 22nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya with cement blocks and dirt mounds. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:35, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin and clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:30. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city and Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh city, stormed and searched several homes, detained resident, then withdrew at 06:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Na’el Abu Qwiek in Al-Bireh city. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 17:15. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Qad until 17:25. (iii) At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababida. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 11:00 and again at 21:00., Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:00.

(iii) Since June 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main entrance to Azzun, the road connecting Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib, closed the road beneath Azzun bridge which connects Azzun and Jayyus and the road connecting Azzun and Kafr Laqif • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village until 10:40. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 00:30. • Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 03:30. • Detention: At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya detained Taher Al-Aqra’ (17 years old). • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osirin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osirin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Osirin until 23:15 • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya and Al-Masaudi area near Burqa village as they escorted several workers from the Israeli Ministry of Antiquities then withdrew at 09:40 (ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Yatma village, clashed with several residents, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 13:05. (iii) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, clashed with several residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 19:30. (iv) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Awarta, opened fire as they stormed and searched several homes (including several Security Force officers homes) and as a result damaged several pieces of furniture and temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli intelligence officers and detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:50. (v) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp handed out several match boxes with “Be Cautious from Hamas before they enflame the West Bank” printed on them. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ammar Adili (16 years old) in Osirin village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ayman Darawsheh and Murad Obidat in Awarta.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to tw9 detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 15:50, Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:30. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:40 on June 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Beit Jallah with steel gates. (x) Since 18:40, Israeli forces closed all entrances and by pass roads leading to the main road in Al-Ubeidiya. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Container checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khadr Bridge until 19:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 10:20. (ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar then stormed several stone saw mills, temporarily detained 4 residents and released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 01:30. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:30. (iv) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Muhanad Hamara in Husan village. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samou' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Annun. (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta. (x) Since 08:00 on June 15th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the North entrance of Hebron. (xi) Since 19:30 on June 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Einun village with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Halhul Bridge until 09:00. (ii) At 05:55 and again at 19:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris and prevented residents from entering or leaving the area until 06:15. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Rish and Al-Aqala village, stormed and searched several water wells then withdrew at 15:00. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Nuba until 12:30. (iii) At 12:00 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Kahil, clashed with its residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes. (iv) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 2 homes and confiscated surveillance camera a footage. (v) At 15:55, Israeli forces raided Dura and Khursa village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child : Yunis Al-Rujub (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised (vi) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna. (vii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', stormed and searched a home, opened fire towards several residents and as a result injured a resident as they detained him then withdrew at 00:40. (viii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Amarah, stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 02:00. (ix) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, clashed with residents in Sa'ir as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result killed a 65 year old resident after she suffered a heart attack as result of the attack on her home and injured 9 residents and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation and detained 3 residents. (x) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several homes and detained 2 residents. • Killing: Israeli forces killed Fatima Rushdi (65 years old) in Al-Urub camp. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:15 on June 25th 2014, Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Abu Aysheh during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the report of June 25th 2014. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Al-Hawamdeh in Al-Samou'. (iii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Diya' Al-Badawi, Ismail Hamjarah and Sa'id Hamajreh in Al-Urub camp. (iv) Israeli forces detained Rami Qawasri and Amir Qawasri in Hebron. (v) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Niruj and Amr Niruj in Hebron. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
