WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint leading to Ramallah and as a result impeded the free flow of traffic towards Ramallah then reopened it later.
- (iii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces closed Hizma checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.
- (v) At 01:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba' checkpoint, which connects Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho, impeded the free flow of traffic then reopened it later.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Majlis gate (one of the main entrance gates leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem detained Bara' Abidien (A resident of Jerusalem).
- (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces detained Doud Al-Ghoul (A resident of Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.

• Attack:

- (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu'fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	(iii) At 00:20, Israeli forces positioned at the North junction of Al-Ram fired
	rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several

	• Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the

	• Settler Violence: At 24:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over an unidentified woman
	near Bab Al-Amoud area and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions during
	which clashes erupted between Israeli forces and local residents who protested the
	incident.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and
	impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an

	iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109.
	Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the
	Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village
	through the Habla gate.
	• <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17 th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem;
	the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement
	of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the
	southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 23:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of
	Beit Furiq until 01:00.
	• Raid: At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummrin village.
NABLUS	• Temporary Detention: On the morning of June 25 th 2015, Israeli forces positioned
	at Jabal Abbil located in North Nablus temporarily detained Murad Sawalha (A resident of Assirah Al-Shimaliya) as he was herding his goats in the area then released him later.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city
	to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from
SALFIT	08:00 until 09:20.
	(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.
	• Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and
	impeded the free flow of traffic.

	Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set
JERICHO	up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
	• Raid: At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and positioned in front of
	Palestinian National Security Force headquarters then withdrew later.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 15:20.
- (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction (located at the South entrance of Bethlehem) until 24:00.
- (iii) At 21:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 24:00.
- (iv) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 23:00.
- (v) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabah village until 23:00.
- **Detention:** At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Muhanad Muslih (A resident of Za'tara).
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

BETHLEHEM

Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green

(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron.
- (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar, impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged for the alleged shooting incident towards a military watch tower located at the entrance of Beit Ummar.
- (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 23:15.
- <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces stormed a Gas station in Beit Ummar and confiscated surveillance camera footage.

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli force broke the cease-fire agreement and opening fire towards Khan Yunis.

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. KHAN YUNIS Attack: At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Abbassan Al-Kabbirah.
