JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Obstruction of places of Worship:</u> On the morning of June 26th 2012, Israeli forces raided Al-Aqsa mosque compound under the protection of Israeli forces and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On June 26th 2012, Israeli Authorities approved the construction of 180 settlement unites on land occupied in 1967 in Jerusalem.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Silwad and Yabrud village as well as detaining a resident. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Rami Yusuf at a checkpoint near Yabrud. • Settler Violence: At 18:00, Israeli settlers set up tents near Burqa village junction in protest to Israeli authorities' decision to dismantle a settlement unite. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bir Al-Basha village junction and detained a resident. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababida and Qabatiya. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Yamun village, stormed a home, temporarily detained and interrogated Ibrahim Nawahda releasing him at a later time. (iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Sila Al-Harhiya, stormed 2 homes, detained Mohammad Ziyoud and Mohammad Tihniya until 07:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Abdel Karim Sabah near Bir AlBasha village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. • Raid: At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Tayasir village and stormed a home. • Deportation: At 10:00, Israeli forces deported residents in the northern area in Tubas to leave the area from 14:00 on June 26th 2012 until 15:00 on June 27th 2012 in order to conduct military exercises.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-

	<p>Labad town to Shufa village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli army continues their restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village. • Raid: At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwiekiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • Provocation of Palestinian Forces: At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near Palestinian Security forces in the area near Far’un and withdrew at a later time. • Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jit village junction. (ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Qalqilya. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Hajja and Al-Funduq village • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Laqif village. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jit village. • Settler Violence: At 15:15, Israeli forces raided agricultural land in Kafr Laqif and damaged olive grove limbs owned by Suliman Hassan. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed a building, summoned Bashar Al-Masri and Ismail Okal to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • Detention: At 13:50, Israeli forces detained Amid Shalabi and Adham Hsalabi as they were reporting to Israeli intelligence in Huwara military base.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At dawn on June 27th 2012, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed home and the office PLC deputy and confiscated a computer. • Detention: At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Sadiq Odeh a resident of Allar and was beat while being interrogated by an Israeli intelligence officer and released him at 11:00. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:50 and again at 06:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 06:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village. • Raid: At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jabr camp until 03:55.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al

	<p>Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.</p> <p>(ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Tuqu' with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area in Beit Sahur. • <u>Raid:</u> <p>(i) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Taqou', searched 2 homes, detained a child then withdrew at 01:45.</p> <p>(ii) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Duhashiya camp, clashed with residents and withdrew at 05:05.</p> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hamza Jibril in Taqou' • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
<p style="text-align: center;">Hebron</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.</p> <p>(v) Since 17:15 on June 17th 2012, Israeli forces continue to close the southern entrance to Al-Samou' with dirt mounds.</p> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <p>(i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabun area located in northern Hebron.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Ramadin village junction.</p> <p>(iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron.</p> <p>(iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.</p> • <u>Raids:</u> <p>(i) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents.</p> <p>(ii) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Biet Kahil, searched 2 homes, and detained 2 residents including university student.</p> • <u>Detention:</u>

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 4 projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Attack: At 18:30 on June 25th 2012, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
