	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to		
QALQILYA	search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the		
	village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows		
	residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at		
	the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students		
	to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.		
	• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of		
	Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-		
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the		
	settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the		
	village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the		
	village of Osrin.		
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the		
	southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and		
	Qaryut.		
	<u>Checkpoint Closures:</u> At 12:20 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces increase		
NABLUS	its restrictions at Huwwara and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:40.

	• <u>Detention</u> : Israeli forces detained Mohammad Atawi and Abdallah Atawi

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two		

	detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.		
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to		
	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years,		
	and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of		
	traffic.		
	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint		
	and impede the free flow of traffic.		
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya		
	town southeast of the illegal settlement.		
	• <u>Closure of Main Road</u> : The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between		
	Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks.		
	• Checkpoints:		
	(i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up		
	along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to		
JERICHO	residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area.		
	(ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on		
	the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho		
	District and others with access permits.		
	• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 13:55, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 14:05.		
	<u>Closure</u> :		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the		
	exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of		
	the village.		
	(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from		
	accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya		
	area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.		
	<u>Closure of Main Roads</u> :		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road		
BETHLEHEM	east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al		
	Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a		
	villages.		
	(ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to		
	Tuqu' with dirt mounds.		
	• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>		
	(i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Nashash junction until 16:45.		
	(ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khadr until 20:15.		
	• <b>Detention:</b> As mentioned in the previous report, at 01:15 on June 27th		
	2012, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sabagh (15 years) during their raid		
	into Taqou'.		
	<u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.		
	• <u>Closure</u> :		
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq		
	Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition		
	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues		
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables		
	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.		
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the		
	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall		
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them		

access to the area.
<u>Closure of Main Roads</u> :
(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-
Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil
villages.
(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling
along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to
the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
(v) Since 17:15 on June 17 <sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces continue to close the southern
entrance to Al-Samou' with dirt mounds.
• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya until 21:00.
• <u>Raids:</u>
<ul> <li>At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta, searched 12 homes, detained a child and temporarily detained several resident including a civil defence officer then withdrew at 05:00.</li> </ul>
(ii) At dawn on June 28 <sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces raided Ithna and Beit Kahil, searched
10 homes, and detained a residents.
• <u>Detention:</u>
(i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Adra (17 years) in Yatta.
(ii) Israeli forces detained Ziad Bawasra in Ithna.
• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
