JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque compound. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Ikka. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. (iii) On 28 May 2010, the Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Ikka, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and told civilians to pass through Qalandiya checkpoint to Jerusalem city. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. (ii) As of 11 April 2010, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp in the city of Jerusalem and prevent daily civilian traffic access from 23:00 until 05:00. The closure of the checkpoint will continue for a week and half under the pretext of maintenance and setting up an infrastructure between the checkpoint and the road leading to Shu'fat refugee camp. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:30 on 28 June 2010, the Israeli army raided the town of Ar Ram and patrolled the area. • <u>Arrest:</u> On 28 June 2010, the Israeli army arrested in the occupied old city of Jerusalem the civilian Islam Barakat Neiroukh. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu’fat refugee camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. (ii) On 15 March 2010, the Israeli army issued military order declaring the area located between civilian houses and the Wall in the town of Ni’lin and the village of Bil’in as closed military zones from 08:00 until 20:00 every Friday and for a period of 6 months. Civilian access is denied during the mentioned period without a special permit in order to prevent the weekly demonstrations against the Wall. • Flying Checkpoint: At 18:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint under the overpass leading to the village of Kharbatha Al Misbah and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raid: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the village of An Nabi Salih and searched a number of houses. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the towns and villages of ‘Abud and Bil’in, and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to ‘Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. • Flying Checkpoints: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to ‘Arraba town and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 15:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of Az Zababida and Qabatiya and arrested 2 civilians. (iii) At 04:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near Haddad Tourist Village and searched civilians and vehicles. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Ya’bad until 12:00. (ii) At 01:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Jenin city. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the area between the towns of Az Zababida and Qabatiya the civilians Ghassan Ahmad Abu Ali and Salih Abdulateef As-Sa’di. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.

At 14:00, the Israeli army erected 2 caravans and increased reinforcements by erecting cement blocks and barbed wire in the periphery of the checkpoint.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:35, Israeli army helicopter airborne infantry troops raided and combed the area located between the villages of Al Far'a and Sirees. (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Tubas city. (iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Aqaba, detained 2 civilians while patrolling the area and released them at a later time and withdrew at 04:15.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to Zeita town and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the neighborhood of Irtah in the city of Tulkarm. (ii) At 15:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Lid, arrested a child and detained 2 civilians and released them after conducting field interrogation with them. (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Tulkarm city. (iv) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Deir Al Ghusun. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested in the town of Beit Lid 16-year-old child Uday Abdulfattah Ghazal. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Azzun. Again at 20:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near Al Funduq village and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 20:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Immatin and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 20:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the village of Izbat At-Tabib (on Qalqiliya – Nablus main road) and searched civilians and vehicles.

	<p>(v) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Kafr Laqif.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 16:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha and served notices for demolishing 2 houses belonging to the civilians Sami Abdulrahman Odeh and his brother Adel under the pretext of not having construction licenses. • Wall Gates: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</p> <p>(ii) On 12 May 2010, the Israeli army erected an iron gate at the entrance to the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha (after removing the iron gate erected at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya), and prevented civilians from the village from passing through it. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through the iron gate # 109.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan; the southern entrances to the villages of Duma and Qaryut; and the western entrance to An Naqura village opposite Shavei Shomron settlement.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: <p>(i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00.</p> <p>(ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00.</p> <p>(iii) At 17:20, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded civilian access.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoints: <p>(i) At 08:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Asira Ash Shamaliya and the village of Ijnisinya.</p> <p>(ii) At 12:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of Asira Ash Shamaliya.</p> <p>(iii) At 13:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Badhan Road (the eastern entrance to Nablus city) and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 23:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Asira Ash Shamaliya and searched a number of houses.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Arrests:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) It was found out that the Israeli army arrested at Huwwara checkpoint at 21:10 on 27 June 2010 the civilians Isma'il Muhammad Turki 'Okal, 16-year-old, and Ma'az Mahmoud Turyaqi under the pretext of finding explosive devices in their possession, as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At 02:05 on 28 June 2010, the Israeli army arrested during a raid on the city of Nablus, in addition to what was mentioned in the previous report, the civilian Jihad Fuad Yousef Al 'Olbeh.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the entrances of 2 side roads between the village of Marda and its agricultural land. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Kifl Hares. (ii) At 19:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Bidhya and the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan. • <u>Raids:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided Rafat village and opened fire indiscriminately while patrolling the area. (ii) At 17:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Az-Zawiya town. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those possessing permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Mu'arrajat Road (which connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah) and searched civilians and vehicles.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu'a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq'a. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) Having evacuated civilian residents and denied civilian access, the Israeli army continues to close the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Ash Shalala Old Street in the old city of Hebron. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades an entrance to the town of Beit Ummar near the town's cemetery. (v) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road connecting the city of Hebron to the town of Adh Dhahiriya, the road

	<p>leading to the town of As-Samoa', the entrance to the village of Abda and the road between the town of Dura and the village of Wadi Ash Shajina.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Wadi Qabun (on the northern entrance to the city of Hebron off bypass road # 35) and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, served summons to a number of civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency and arrested a civilian. Again at 13:30, the Israeli army raided the city, took position opposite Al Muqata'a building (the security compound), took photographs for the guards at its gate, took position opposite another headquarter belonging to the Palestinian National Security and photographed it and patrolled the area. Again at 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area. (ii) At 10:35, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Deir Samit. (iii) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Yatta town. (iv) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Idhna, searched 4 houses, arrested a General Intelligence Officer and withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) In the morning of 28 June 2010, the Israeli army arrested at the entrance to the town of Beit Ummar the civilian Uday Mahmoud Abdulaziz Awad who allegedly had a knife in his possession. (ii) The Israeli army arrested in Hebron city the civilian Noor Nabil Imran Ash Sharbati. (iii) The Israeli army arrested in Idhna town Officer Noor Salameh Al Kharouf. • <u>Detention:</u> At 15:10, the Israeli army detained in the old city of Hebron Police Officer Hasan Falah Ahmad An-Natsheh and released him following DCO intervention at 15:45. • <u>Attack on Religious Site:</u> At 22:00, the Israeli army stormed Al Qazzazeen Mosque in the old city of Hebron and took photographs for the mosque's inside. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers in Tal Ar-Rumeida neighborhood in the old city of Hebron cut off and destroyed an old Roman olive tree planted in a plot of land belonging to Al Jabali family. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

GAZA STRIP

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period. • The Israeli army violated the ceasefire by raiding Palestinian territory and opening fire in Rafah district. The Israeli army also opened fire intensively and fired 3 artillery shells from its locations on the Green Line in the districts of Gaza and Khan Yunis. An Israeli UAV aircraft fired a missile on Gaza district killing an armed Palestinian individual and injuring 3 others, including 1 with serious injuries. • Armed Palestinian groups breached the ceasefire by firing a mortar towards the Green Line, opening fire and firing anti-armor mortar towards an Israeli army patrol near the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is partially open for the transport of wheat and fodder. (ii) Al-Shuja'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision. • Palestinian Attacks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) In the afternoon of 28 June 2010, a mortar was fired towards the Green Line. (ii) At 16:10, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire and fired an anti-armor mortar towards an Israeli army patrol near the Green Line, east of Al-Shuja'iyah neighborhood that is located east of Gaza city. Consequently, the Israeli army opened fire intensively and fired 3 artillery shells. An Israeli UAV aircraft also fired a missile towards armed Palestinians killing 1 and injuring 3 others, including 1 with serious injuries. • Killing: The Israeli army killed east of Al-Shuja'iyah neighborhood, east of Gaza city, Bassam Ibrahim Badwan.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is open. It allowed the departure of civilian patients, students and visa holders, and the entry of civilians and patients who received treatment at Egyptian hospitals. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transport of food, humanitarian assistance and cooking gas. • Raid: In the morning of 28 June 2010, the Israeli army, including a number of armored vehicles and bulldozers covered by reconnaissance aircrafts, raided 200 meters inside Palestinian territory east of An Nahda neighborhood, that is located east of Rafah city, and opened fire intensively towards agricultural land while leveling an area of agricultural land.

(ii) The Israeli military court at 'Ofer Military Camp sentenced political prisoner Farid Humaidan Al Uwaiwi from the old city of Hebron to 9 months in prison and a fine of 5000 shekel (equivalent to \$1300)
