WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed Hizma checkpoint located at the east entrance of Jerusalem and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- Expulsion: On June 29th 2014, Israeli forces served 2 residents: Akram Sharafeh and Anwar Ajuj expulsion orders preventing them from entering Al-Aqsa Mosque compound for a period of 6 months.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:40 on June 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Beit Jallah with steal gates.
- (x) At 18:30, Israeli forces closed all entrances and by pass roads leading to the main road din Al-Ubeidiya.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Husan until 23:20.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along

- the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 016:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Suba village junction.

• **Raid:**

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Kahil, stormed and searched a Plastic manufacturing company then withdrew at 16:20.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Halhul, stormed and searched 3 homes and as a result damaged home furniture owned by: Abdel-Hamid Dandis, Khalil Abu Siyam and Mustafa Tafish and detonated several caves using explosives in west Beiot Kahil then withdrew at 21:50
- (iii) At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Dura and stormed and searched 3 homes.
- (iv)At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several homes and merchant shops and detained 2 residents

• Detention:

- (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces detained Azmi Abu Sneineh in Abu Sneneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Qawasmeh and Ishaq Al-Saqafi in Hebron.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire and launching tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats of the shores Khan Yunis.
- Israeli fighter Jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 3 consecutive strikes towards, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured 2 Palestinian gunmen.
- Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 16 projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Authorities).

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Palestinian Attack:
 - (i) At 20:10, Palestinian Gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green

	Line (As alleged by the Israeli Authorities). (ii) On the morning of 30\06\2014, Palestinian Gunmen launched 2 projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Air Strike: At 02:00 on June 29th 2014, Israeli fighter jets launched missiles a plot of land located North West of Al-Nassariya camp. Palestinian Attack: At 20:10, Palestinian Gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Authorities).
KHAN YUNIS	 Attack: On the evening of June 29th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Khan Yunis. Air Strike: On the evening of June 29th 2014, Israeli Drones launched missiles towards Palestinian gunmen in east Al-Qarara and as a result killed a resident and injured 2 others. Killing: Israeli air strikes killed Mohammad Abu Rizq in Al-Qarara. Palestinian Attack: (i) On the evening of June 29th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen opened fire towards an Israeli military vehicle near the border fence during which Israeli forces returned fire and launched tank artillery shells towards agricultural land in Al-Qarara. (ii) At 07:00, Palestinian Gunmen launched 10 projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Authorities).
RAFAH	• Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students, tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, executives, and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination, diesel fuel for electric generators.
