JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound except for Women, Permit holders and emergency cases. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Ram junction. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Qalandiya camp. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Gharbiya after storming his home in Al-Sunah village. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint detained Shadi Jabarin for allegedly carrying a rifle.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On June 29th 2015, Israeli forces stormed the south area of Al-Eisawiya village and served military orders for the confiscation of hundreds of acres of land. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police and Military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Ras Kar Kar and Al-Janiya villages. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of AL-Nabi Saleh village until 01:50. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Turmus’aya, Obwein, Ajol, Al-Mughier, and Deir Ijrier villages (after the alleged drive by shooting near “Shivat Arahil” settlement in Nablus which left 4 Israeli settlers injured), set up several checkpoints in and around the area, searched several homes, detained 3 residents including a woman and a child in Al-Mughier village and confiscated surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops in Al-Mughier and Deir Ijrier villages. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, Kafr Malik and Ain Yabroud villages (for the alleged fire bombing of an Israeli settler’s vehicle near “Bet El settlement) during which they clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and confiscated surveillance camera footage from several merchant shops in Kafr Malik and Ein Yabroud. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Rasmi Hamad, Ayoub Hamad (16 years old) and Moath Hamad in Al-Mughier village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:45, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road near the settlement, which leads to Al-Jalazoun camp during which clashes erupted between residents and Israeli forces as they attempted to prevent the settler attack.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jamala crossing point which is located along the Green Line in North Jenin temporarily detained Moayad Al-Sa’di (Mentally ill) for allegedly throwing fire crackers and fire works towards Israeli soldiers at the crossing point then released him at 17:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those

	holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 15:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. At 01:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 02:10. At 03:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area. • Raid: At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Ras Attiya village levelled a plot of agricultural land approximately three dunumes owned by Maher Abdel-Haq and uprooted several trees and confiscated them and then withdrew at 09:00. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 01:05, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at Qusra and Osirin village junctions until 02:55. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> At 00:05, Israeli forces raided Qaryout village (after the alleged drive by shooting near "Shivat Arahil" settlement in Nablus, which left 4 Israeli settlers injured), set up several checkpoints at its entrance and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area. 	<p>(iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Qusra village (after the alleged drive by shooting near “Shivat Arahil” settlement in Nablus which left 4 Israeli settlers injured), clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, set up several checkpoints in and around the village and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area, detained 4 residents, temporarily detained 2 residents including a Police officer: Mu’taz Al-Aqwra’ (A Police officer) and Adnan Hani then released them after assaulting them and Israeli forces also assaulted Hassan Abu Mustafa (A resident of Balata camp) then withdrew at 04:35.</p> <p>(iv) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, detained a resident after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 04:35.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained four residents: Osama Abu Shihab, Suliman Qadri, Shadi Qadri and Wajdi Fatallah in Qusra village. (ii) Israeli force detained Mohammad Shouli in Assirah Al-Shimaliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 03:40 on June 29th 2015, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they raided Tel village and as a result injured Amir Mohammad leaving him hospitalised. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 04:10, Israeli settlers positioned near “Yitsahar” settlement in North Huwara stoned residents and vehicles.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 01:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On June 28th 2015, Israeli Military issued an order for the confiscation of a plot of land approximately 4 dunumes (acres) owned by Abdallah Khater for the purpose of expanding the area of “Brujin” settlement located in the north area of Brujin..
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Ne’umeh village located at the north entrance of Jericho until 13:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, positioned in front of Palestinian National Security force headquarters then withdrew at 20:20. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Abdallah Zakarneh as he was returning from Jordan then released him after summoning him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area

	<p>in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarah village, stormed and searched the home of Maysoun Al-Jabali {who was detained for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier at checkpoint "300"} then withdrew at 13:35. (ii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah village, summoned Ahmad Omar to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:35. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 03:15. • <u>Detention:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at checkpoint "300" located in North Bethlehem detained Maysoun Al-Jabali {A resident of Al-Shuwarah village and University student} for allegedly stabbing an Israeli soldier. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Rakaba area in Al-Khader and served a military order for the demolition of livestock dens owned by Ibrahim Subieh for allegedly being built without a licence.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to closed Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. <p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
