JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On February 21st 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a resident. (iii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged

(ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Babn Al-Amoud gate detained Mohammad Rashq. (iii) Israeli forces detained Hamad Rajabi near Bab Al-Amoud Gate. (iv) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Abu Shawish in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:15, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem, stoned several homes during which Israeli forces opened fire towards a building. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabrud bridge until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya and summoned Jamal Al-Qadi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:50. (ii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ein village, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Turmus'ayya, served 2 residents: Ahmad

	<p>Shalabi and Wasti Odeh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:00.</p> <p>(iv) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village and summoned Mohammad Ghani to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hisham Al-Eis in Kfr Ein village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Musa Alqam while he was farming his agricultural land near “Talmoun settlement” then released him at 11:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned at Atara bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a Police officer: Mohammad Shalash and Mohammad Zayed. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ofar prison in Beituniya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Hamid Hamayil (17 years old), Musa Abu Qabta and Mohammad Alaa. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalzoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents: Ahmad Karajeh, Suliman Kan’an, Yusef Mahmoud, Nur Saqer and Salam Al-Saf’i. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces, and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation (ii) At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Bil’in village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Taybeh village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Jenin and Bruqin. (ii) At 17:35, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad until 19:50. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic as the temporarily detained 5 residents then released them at 12:55. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near Ibziq village temporarily detained 2 residents: Badran Al-Hourub (14 years old) and Hillal Al-Hourub then released them at 13:20.

<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up checkpoint between Hajja and Kafr Qaddum villages. (iii) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum and damaged windows of a home owned by Jamal Jum’a. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Qaryut village protesting against settler violence during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades

(ii) At 14:50, Israeli settlers stormed Huwara and assaulted 2 residents: Ahmad Odeh and Foad Odeh leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Salfit, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel gate then reopened it at 17:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya until 23:05. (ii) At 06:20, Israeli forces raided Salfit until 07:25. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Oja village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:40, Israeli settlers forcibly removed several families from their agricultural land as they were herding sheep in Ein Dweik Al-Fouqa.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khadr bridge until 14:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village until 21:50 (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Wadi Fuqin village then withdrew at 22:30. (iii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha and summoned Mohammad Abu Sarour to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bilal Bin Rabah mosque located in north Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

(iv)At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 02:00. (v) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Tafuh, summoned Husam Talib to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:00. (vi)At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 03:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned Al-Shalashleh road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Naji Al-Rajabi (17 years old) and Firas Al-Turk. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village and at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iii)At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Kahil fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result killed an Elderly resident. • Israeli air force broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles towards North
