<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint, which is located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 14:15. (ii) At 13:20, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Duquq village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Ram detained two residents: Ahmad Ghatit and Ali Sandouka (Both residents of Al-Ram). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Wad area located in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained the child Mustafa Abu Snieneh (13 years old) then released him later. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces positioned at Hizma checkpoint assaulted Mohammad Al-Joulani (A resident of Shu’fat camp) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned at Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sur Bahar village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 02:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Silwan neighbourhood opened fire towards several residents for allegedly attempting to throw a fire bomb towards the settlement. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet until 16:35. (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sinya village Circle located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus until 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces raided Mazra’e Al-Nubani village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result injured Bara’ Kafayeh (A resident of Beit Iksa) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ofar Military base/Prison opened fire towards several residents and University students for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at a military watch tower located near the entrance of Abboud opened fire in the area. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:20, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp stoned a vehicle owned by Jihad Farah (A resident of Ein Sinya) as he was driving near the area.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces raided Far’oun village and clashed with its residents. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Zieta , clashed with its residents then withdrew at 21:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli force set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Azzun, Izbit Al-Tabib village and along the main road leading to Jayyus and impeded the free flow of traffic for the alleged fire bombing of an Israeli settler vehicle's along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus during which Israeli forces fired stun grenades towards several residents located in the north area of Azzun then resumed the free flow of traffic at 07:10. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 11:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Yistsahar" settlement junction until 13:00. (ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shomron" settlement junction until 16:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 04:10.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Zakariya

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 13:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Aqbat Hasna area located along the main road leading to Husan village until 15:45. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on February 28th 2015, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a home and summoned Ibrahim Hajaj'a to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Duhisheh camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes in the camp and as a result injured Mohammad Al-Sayfi and Abdallah Salim leaving them hospitalised with contusions, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. (iii) At dawn on March 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashaydeh village

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar until 15:15. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron until 23:20. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp until 23:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and stormed and searched a home. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Mohammad Abu Akrer (A resident of Hebron) for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.
