	• <u>Closure</u> :
	(i) Since January 13 th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

	(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
	(ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem.
	 Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. 	 the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

	 (i) As mentioned in the previous report, at 04:30 on March 1st 2012, Israeli forces detained Saleh Abu Zaid, Tarek Abu Arrub, Ibrahim Suti and Ahmad Kameel during their raid into Qabatia. (ii) Israeli force detained Mohammad Muradi during their raid into Arraba.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Aqaba village junction.
	 Raid: At 13:25 and again at 16:30, Israeli forces raided Tayasir village. At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Aqaba village and set up a checkpoint at its entrance then withdrew at 17:30.

GAZA STRIP

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Palestinian gunmen launched 3 projectiles towards the Green Line. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Palestinian Attack: On the evening of March 1st 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
