<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 23:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint, which is located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Duquq village. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Dahiyat Al-Barid circle in Jerusalem. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint detained Alaa Abu Gharbiya (A resident of Al-Ram). (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Thuri neighbourhood detained two residents: Omar Sarhan and Hatem Al-Shubaki. (iii) At dawn on March 2nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood detained five residents: Yusef Abu Jum’a, Mahdi Al-Sayad, Muhanad Ghayth, Basil Al-Halabi and Kamil Al-Alami. (iv) At dawn on March 2nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained three residents: Khalil Al-Shawish, Ma’moun Ghayth and Mansour Saleem. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On March 1st 2015, Israeli forces stormed AL-Shiekh Jarrah

	<p>neighbourhood and served military orders for the demolition of a building “Al-Sumod Camp” which houses 35 families for allegedly being built without a licence which is owned by The Palestinian Religious Authority.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of March 1st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli Military continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 15:40, the Israeli Military closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazoun camp and near “Bet El” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic for allege military exercises. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Surda village junction. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ain Sinya (located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus). (iii) At 15:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Yabrud village. (iv) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Kamil Karat and Mohammad Hashiqa in Beituniya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Turmus’aya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:45, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh city stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road near the settlement.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:40 and again at 19:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 08:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:25 on March 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Anabta until 09:05.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village until 16:00. (iii) At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 16:00. (iv) At 17:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Jinsafut village junction • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 11:40. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Azzun Atma village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents attempting to cross into Israel for work. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Assira Al-Shimaliya, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew ta 05:55. (ii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Wazan village until 05:55. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Shuoli in Assira Al-Shimaliya.

<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 21:00 and again at 07:35, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Jericho until 09:20. (ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village until 21:45.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

(iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed several homes, damaged house furniture owned by Khled Al-Harimi then withdrew at 07:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jamal Al-Harimi in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned in Um Al-Rakaba area in Al-Khader fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and occupied Husam Salah's home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 17:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul Bridge. (ii) At 08:10, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along Wadi Qabun junction located in north Hebron city. (iii) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Tarqumiya junction. (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im. (v) At 18:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou'. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on March 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron city, stormed a home and summoned Fahed Al-Qasrawi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At dawn on March 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, stormed several homes, detained three residents and summoned Sari Abu Hash-Hash to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit, stormed, and searched a

(ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ibrahim Teeti, Rami Teeti and Wa'ed Al-Badu in Al-Fuwar camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained two residents: Ahmad Idris and Yusef Al-Natsheh. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of March 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Sha'eb Al-Sier area located in Beit Ummar and near "Karmi Tsur" settlement, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> On March 1st 2015, Israeli forces confiscated a truck owned by Yatta Municipality after forcibly removing the driver from the area (which makes it five remaining vehicles owned by Yatta Municipality). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of March 1st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Hadgi" settlement located in south Hebron stoned residents and vehicles passing along the road near the settlement.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval Vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza.
