- <u>Attack:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Al-Za'im checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Omar Sarhan leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- Confiscation of Property: On March 2nd 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Khan Al-Hamra area in Jerusalem and confiscated 2 trucks carrying playground equipment to be installed in a children's play ground in the area for allegedly not having proper licencing to build the playground.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> On March 2nd 104, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Baba in east Eizariya and served a demolition order for a home owned by Suliman Al-Hajali for allegedly being built without a licence.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of March 2nd 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh.

- (i) On March 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, stormed several homes, detained a resident and summoned Mohammad Al-Tel to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then again at 01:50 on March 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:50.
- (ii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Mugheir village, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:25.

Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge.

Raid:

- (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Tawani village in east Yatta prevented the construction of a children's Kindergarten and confiscated several tons of cement and construction material and assaulted Fadel Jibril leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar until 22:30.
- (iii)On the evening of March 2nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, occupied the roof top of a home owned by Mohammad Ayash and converted it into a military post, fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocating rom tear gas inhalation.
- (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im until 06:00.
- (v) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron detained 3 residents then withdrew

at 03:20.

- (vi) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir until 04:45.
- (vii)At dawn on March 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli force detained 3 residents: Anas Qawasmi, Ahmad Al-Daba'at and Majd Al-Qawasmi in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Haribat in Dura.

• Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp temporarily detained Khaled Salim (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 10:35.
- (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village temporarily detained Ghalib Abu Arqoub (12 years old) then released him at a later time.

• Attack:

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

Attack: At 06:00 on March 1st 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. 		
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
