JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, continue to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained 2 residents. (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, clashed with residents then withdrew at 18:30.

(ii) Israeli forces detained Shadi Far'un and Muhanad Hamida in Al-Eizariya. (iii) Israeli forces detained Karim Al-Faqiya in Qutna village. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:00, Israeli settlers marched in the streets of the old city of Jerusalem and near Al-Aqsa mosque compound and chanted Anti Arab slogans. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, clashed with residents, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning them. (iii) At 22:55, Israeli force raided Sinariya village until 23:15. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed and searched 2 buildings, home and merchant store then withdrew at 04:25. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Munthir Ghanam and Ahmad Ghanam as they were working in "Amano'el" settlement. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 11:20, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:30. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Laban Al-Sharqiya junction until 16:30. (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction, temporarily detained Ibrahim Ghannim then released him at 17:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 11:30. (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village until 14:20. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho, stormed and searched 5 homes then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces stormed Fasayil village, served demolition orders for 3 homes owned by : Sami Hassan, Sadam Rashaydeh and Mohammad Rashaydeh and served demolition orders for 2 barracks owned Abdallah Farinat and Issa Farinat for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement

	<p>,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Hussan, Nihalin, Bettar and Wadi Fuqin and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:25. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou’, until 01:30 (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Bettar village, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 03:15. (iii)At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Doha, detained a resident in Al-Doha then withdrew at 03:15. (iv)At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Nihalin, stormed a home then withdrew at 04:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdel Aziz Issa in Al-Doha. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

 - (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge until 14:30.
 - (ii) At 09:35 and again at 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im until 22:35.
 - (iii) At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Halhul until 13:05.
 - (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 23:40.
 - (iii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou' until 01:40.
 - (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed and searched several homes, detained 8 residents then withdrew at 06:10.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 01:30 on March 3rd 2014, Israeli force detained Yahya Al-Qanbi in Hebron in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
 - (ii) At 03:20 on March 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Yusef Al-Aramin in Sair in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
 - (iii) At dawn on March 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Ayahab Harbiyat in Dura in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
 - (iv) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned at "Mitar" crossing located along the Green Line in south of Al-Thariya detained Maysoun Al-Sabouti, a resident of Beit Awa as she was visiting her husband in Israeli jail (Nafhat).
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Omar Adouri and Obada Adouri in Al-Urub camp.
 - (vi) Israeli forces detained 8 residents: Barakat Mar, Mahmoud Mar, Mohammad Barakat Anana Barakat, Jibril Barakat, Hassan Barakat , Ibrahim Mar and Khalil Mar in Yatta.
- **Physical Assault:** At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at "Metar crossing located along the Green Line assaulted Ahmad Fa'eq Najarrat and Ahmad Ali Najjarat leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at Jabal juhar in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
