## Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Lagef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i)

- The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the (ii) southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

### **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00
- At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to (ii) cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- At 10:20 and again at 19:40, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at (iii) Shave Shomron checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

   (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Taqou with dirt mounds.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Sahur until 11:55.

- (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, stormed a home, temporarily detained and interrogated several residents then withdrew at 11:35.
- (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Beit Jala until 15:35.
- (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha until 14:40.
- (iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur.
- (v) At 17:05, forces raided Husan village and stormed a home then withdrew at 17:30.
- (vi) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Al- Ubeidiya, stormed a home, summoned Jamal Shanayta to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:55.
- <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 11:25, Israeli forces served demolition orders to Mahmoud Jubran, Imad Jubran and Mohammad Barmil to demolish their homes, constructed in Areas C, for allegedly being built without proper licensing.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

### • Closure:

- (vii) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (viii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.



- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ayash Awad (16 years), Bassim Abu Mariya (17 years) and Mutaz Awad during their raid into Beit Ummar.
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 11:00, family members of detainees and Palestinian peace activists marched in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and to demand their release from Israeli prisons.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
