<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nabalah. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and stormed a home. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Nur-Aldin Hussein. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint temporarily detained Hamza Al-Aghbar (A resident of Nablus) then released him later. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

	<p>devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge until 12:00. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al village, temporarily detained three residents: Abdallah Atta, Amjad Atta and Hassan Zahran then released them at 20:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Mughier village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 15:25, Israeli forces raided Deir Nathim village, temporarily detained 5 residents: including Four children: Ameen Hassan (13 years old), Muqadam Abdel-Haq (13 years old), Eyas Yahya (15 years old), Shihab Al-Tamimi (15 years old) and Ibrahim Al-Tamimi then released them at 19:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Deir Qadis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Layth Nassar (11 years old) then released him at 19:00. • <u>Installation of Military Post:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces installed a military watch tower on land in Beit Illu village near “Naha’il” settlement. • <u>Assault on Health Sector:</u> On 03:30 on March 4th 2015, Israeli forces raided Obwein and stormed a Ministry of Health Clinic and searched it after breaking down the main entrance. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:25, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road near the settlement.

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Detention:</u> On the morning of March 5th 2015, Israeli forces detained Iz-Al-Din Amarneh (A University Professor) {A resident of Ya’bad} as he was attending his sons trial in “Salem” Military base. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint temporarily detained Hamdan Sawafta (A resident of Tubas) then released him at 15:40. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces confiscated a bulldozer and two trucks owned by Mohammad Al-Rawasnah (A resident of Hebron).
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting

	<p>Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Attil.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30 and again at 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 19:30. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Jinsafut village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction (Along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya), temporarily detained Hussien Ali Hussien then released him at 16:00. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in North Huwarah. (iii) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Nablus and Deir Sharaf until 17:50. (iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction until 21:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces raided Burin village (for the alleged assault of an Israeli settler), stormed a home then withdrew at 16:00.

	<p>(ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya and detained two residents.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Tariq Shuli and Qays Jra'at in Assirah Al-Shimaliya.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) Since January 21st 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Deir Istiya with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:50, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 15:55. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jericho until 17:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:50 and again at 22:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 23:45.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt

	<p>mounds.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:35. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Fadi Al-Amouri (A Presidential Guard) {A resident of Ya'bad} as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Husan village temporarily detained the child: Mohammad Hamarat (8 years old) for alleged stoning them released him at 15:00.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque located in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained three children: Mohamad Abu Sneieneh (14 years old), Hassan Abu Marrar (14 years old) and Adrar Al-Fakhouri (14 years old) then released them at 10:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 07:00 on March 4th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Al-Aqba area in the old city of Hebron assaulted the child: Aya Jaber (15 years old) as she was going to school in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron and as a result left her hospitalised with a broken arm and contusions.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
