The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities.</li> <li>Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall continues south of Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River.</li> <li>Land Confiscation: The Israeli army issued confiscation orders for thousands of dunums of land belonging to the towns of Al Yamun and Silat Al Harithiya and the village of Al 'Araqa, in preparation for the expansion of the industrial area near the settlement of Shacked.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints near the southern entrance to the city, another at the entrance to the town of Kafr Ra'i and prevented civilians from entering the area.</li> </ul> |

#### Raids: (i) At 13:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Al Ubeidiya. At 01:30, 7 Israeli army jeeps raided the city of Bethlehem and (ii) arrested a child. (iii) The Israeli army raided the village of Husan and arrested an attorney. (i) The Israeli army arrested Haitham Khalif, 17 years old, from the city. **BETHLEHEM** The Israeli army arrested Izzidin Al Hamara from the village of (ii) **Demonstration:** At 13:10, a demonstration took place in the city of Bethlehem in solidarity with political prisoners and detainees. The demonstration began at the Red Crescent Society and ended in front of the Church of the Nativity. **Separation Wall Gates:** Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Raids: (i) At 07:15, 08:25, 09:05, 09:20, 6 Israeli jeeps raided the city of Tulkarem and opened indiscriminate fire. At 16:50, an Israeli army personnel carrier opened fire at civilians. At 21:00 and 23:15, all Israeli jeeps withdrew under the protection of Israeli helicopters. At 08:50, the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp. At 17:10, (ii) the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp, opened fire and fired sound bombs at civilians. At 17:30, the Israeli army took position at the entrance to Nur Shams (iii) **TULKAREM** refugee camp and detained a child. (iv) At 17:50 and 18:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Beit Lid. At 20:00, an Israeli army jeep raided the town of Bal'a, prevented (v) civilians from moving inside the town and tore up the ID's of 3 civilians. At 20:35, an Israeli jeep raided the village of Kafr al Labad and (vi) provoked civilians into confrontations. **Flying Checkpoints:** At 07:20, an Israeli jeep took position in the centre of the city and (i) paralyzed traffic movement. At 08:00 and 13:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the (ii) junction of Al Jarushiya and prevented traffic movement. (iii) At 08:15 and 15:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint east of Bal'a and another in Dahiyat Shuweika, both preventing civilians from travelling. (iv) At 12:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of
