<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 6th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jib village until 21:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood opened fire towards Mohammad Al-Salamiyah (A resident of Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood){After he allegedly ran over several Israeli Settlers and Israeli Police officers} and as a result left him hospitalised in critical condition after detaining him. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during their raid into Al-Bawaba village {which was established by several local and International Peace Activist on land under threat of Israeli military confiscation in Al-Eizariya} and as a result injured 2 residents: Mahmoud Aliyan (A journalist) and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 14:30 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Ikksa checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area located between Abu Dis and Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned in Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (viii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired

	<p>rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident in the eye after being struck by a rubber coats steel bullet and left several others suffocated from tear gas Inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 6th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood detained Mohammad Maghribi. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jerusalem city detained Ziyad Al-Harimi (A resident of Bethlehem). (iii) Israeli forces positioned at Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained Mohammad Al-Salaymeh after opening fire towards him and left him critically injured. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar village. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Mughier village, detained two residents then withdrew at 20:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar Military Base/ Prison opened fire towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Hamza Al-Qatari (17 years old) and left him hospitalised and detained another child. (iii) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Nathim village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned at Atrah bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including a 3 children {including 1 child critically injured}: Moath Al-Ramahi (14 years old) {critically injured}, Mohammad Hamdan (14 years old), Abdallah Nakhlah (14 years old), Ayman Thaher and Mujahid Ka’abneh. (vi) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad, fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel-Qadder Ayad and Rami Shubaqi. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Billal Abu Aliya and Bashir Abu Alliya in Al-Mughier village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Israeli forces positioned at “Ofar” military base/Prison detained Ma’zouz Abu Radha (16 years old) {A resident of Beituniya} • Temporary Detention: At 19:35, Israeli forces positioned near “Makirion” settlement outpost located in east Burqa temporarily detained three residents including a child: Ghannam Barackat (16 years old), Amir Halami and Imad Abu Sa’ud. • Demonstrations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:25, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Mohammad Abu Rahmeh and also left several others suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation as well as temporarily detaining 4 International Peace Activists {French Citizens}: Kahina Zahar, Falici Besanard, Jazil Jabrah and Allan Fazra.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Attack: On the evening of March 6th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalah checkpoint opened fire towards a civilian vehicle and as a result injured Mustafa Ballout {A resident of Jenin}(Critically injured) and Yusef Abu Na’asah. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
<p style="text-align: center;">TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Tayassir village until 16:10.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 10:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:05. • Raid: At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid until 12:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Raid: At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 13:20. • Attack: At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyus fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Demonstration: At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried

	<p>to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Jameel Ishtewi (12 years old), Assaf Hikmat and HikmatIstewi and also left several demonstrators suffocating form tear gas inhalation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Burin village until 14:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:00, a demonstration took place in Qaryout village protesting against land confiscation and settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who prevented demonstrators from planting Olive trees.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

(ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned in Um AAl-Rakaba area in Al-Khadr fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 23:50. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar temporarily detained Mohammad Awad then released him at 17:20. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis.

	and passengers travelling abroad and through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of March 6th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in east Al-Qarara village.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the entrance of Deasil fuel for the Electric Generator which provides electricity for the Gaza.
