#### • Detention:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Khdeir near the French hill in Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces detained Ayman Al-Sabar Jabal Al Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (iii) On March 7<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Lafi and Mahmoud Abu Lafi in Al-Suwana neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On March 6<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces temporarily detained 50 school girls near Bab A-Absat gate which leads to Al-Aqsa mosque and prevent them from entering the mosque.
- **<u>Destruction o Property:</u>** On the 7<sup>th</sup> of March, Israeli forces serves notification for demolishing of a workshop belonged to Hamza Aslan in Ture neburhood in Jerusalem.
- **Demonstrations:** At 14:00, a demonstration took place in front of the international Red Cross headquarters in Al-Sheikh Jarah neighbourhood in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Ein Samiya area located in east Kafr Malik.
- (ii) At 07:15, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya and Khirbeit Abu Falah
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 07:15, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles near Khirbit Abu Falah and stole 40 heads of Livestock owned by Abdallah Al-Na'san after assaulting him near Mughier village leaving him hospitalised with contusions during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault and injured Ibrahim Abu Aliya, Misbah Abu Aliya, Mohammad Al-Na'san and Samih Abu Aliya then withdrew at 13:00.
