JERUSALEM	 Closure: Since January 13th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem. Pemonstrations: At 12:50, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards Qalandiya checkpoint, on the occasion of International Women's Day, to express in solidarity with Palestinian detainces and demand their release from Israeli jails. - <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 11:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards Al-Walaja village protesting land levelling for the purpose of wall construction
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of BeitJala town.

• Closure:

- (vi) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (vii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.

Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction.
- (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction.

Raids:

- (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, clashed with residents as they stormed the home of a released detainee (released in the Shalit prisoner swap with Israel) and killed a minor wounded in clashes as Israeli forces prevented ambulances from reaching the wounded, then withdrew at 18:00.
- (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp.
- (iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Matina area in Yatta.
- (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Kinar area in Dura.
- **<u>Killing:</u>** Zakaria Abu Arram (17 years) was killed during clashes with Israeli forces during clashed in Yatta.
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 11:25, Palestinians marched in the Old City of Hebron protesting Settler violence and attacks on the home of Hana Abu Haykal.

ALL	agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00.
DISTRICTS	On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark.
	 Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis and Central Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Central Gaza	• <u>Attack:</u> At 07:15, on March 7 th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Al-Bureij camp.
Khan Yunis	• Raid: At 20:15, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided agricultural land as they levelled a plot of land in Al-Qarara.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students and passengers with permits. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.

Detainees Update

• An Israeli military court in Ofer prison sentenced Hamza Baranta, a resident of Bil'in to 18 months in prison in addition to a fine amounting to 5000 NIS (approximately 1300 USD).
