WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Separation Wall Construction: (i) The pace of separation wall construction was accelerated in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis, Al Sawahira and Sur Bahir. (ii) Preparatory work, including land levelling, for construction of the separation wall in Beit Surik and Qatanna remains suspended by order of the Israeli Supreme Court. Raid: The Israeli army raided Dahiyat Al Eizariya and searched several houses.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 FIving Checkpoints: The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the entrances to the villages of Deir Abu Mash'al and An Nabi Salih and detained civilians for several hours. Detention: The Israeli army detained 3 civilians, Awad Abu Samra, his wife, and their 2-day-old baby, while travelling back to their village of Turmus'ayya from Ramallah hospital. The Israeli army forced the family to wait outside for several hours while their vehicle was searched. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the separation wall continues in Budrus, Rantis, Beit Liqya, near Beituniya and near the village of Midya. Civilians from the village of Budrus tore down a portion of the double fenced area of the separation wall constructed on land confiscated from the village. Civilians from Beit Liqya forcibly prevented Israeli bulldozers from destroying their property for construction of the separation wall. Raids: At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh and severely beat 2 civilians, one of whom was later arrested. The Israeli army raided the village of Abud. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested Khalil Idris in the city of Ramallah. The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians on 8 March 2004: Naji Abu Hamid; and Jabir Obeida. Demonstration: At 13:00, hundreds of civilians in the village of Beit Ijza protested against the confiscation of their land for construction of the

	separation wall. The Israeli army opened fire, fired tear gas grenades and sound bombs towards protestors, and severely beat several civilians, injuring 8.
JENIN	 Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Separation Wall Construction: Construction of the separation wall continues south of Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River. Raids: At 11:30, the Israeli army, heavily reinforced and supported by helicopters, raided the city of Jenin, forced entry into several houses in the eastern neighbourhood, opened intensive fire, killing 1 female civilian in her house, and injured 3 civilians, including 1 female, 1 journalist, and 1 male civilian in critical condition. The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians, including 1 officer. Israeli helicopters attacked a Jawwal telecommunications tower, severing the GSM communication network in the area. At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Siris, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. Killing: The Israeli army killed Dalal Al Sabbagh, 22 years old, in the city of Jenin. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the city of Jenin: Anas Hinthawi; Arafat Andil; Muhammad Al Sa'di; and Mu'taz Nassar, a Palestinian Preventive Security officer.
JERICHO	Activities not yet reported.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to surround the villages of Al Arqub, Husan, Battir and Wadi Fukin. Raids: At 18:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Husan, imposed curfew and arrested 1 civilian. At 18:45, 4 Israeli jeeps raided the town of Al Ubeidiya and detained 1 civilian. Between 22:55 and 03:00, the Israeli army, including 2 military personnel carriers, 12 jeeps and Israeli Special Forces in civilian vehicles, raided Beit Jala, Al Duheisha refugee camp, and several neighbourhoods in the city of Bethlehem and arrested 1 officer.

	 Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the district of Bethlehem: (i) Rami Omira, in the village of Husan; and
	(ii) Hilmi Hammash, a Palestinian Police officer.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to block all roads leading from the village of Ramin to Bizzariya with dirt mounds. Flving Checkpoints: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of the town of Bal'a and searched civilians and vehicles. Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Raids: At 07:30, 2 Israeli army jeeps raided the village of Far'un. At 11:30, several Israeli jeeps raided the village of Kafr Al Labad, searched several houses and opened indiscriminate fire. At 14:50, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the town of Anabta and ran over 1 child. At 18:10, and again at 21:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Far'un and opened fire. At 21:00, the Israeli army, including 1 tank, 4 military personnel carriers and 5 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp and arrested 4 civilians, including 2 children. Arrests: At 09:30, the Israeli army arrested 1 Palestinian National Security officer in the city of Tulkarem. Maher Hussein. The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the city of Tulkarem: Muhammad Nassar, 17 years old; Majdi Ramzi, 17 years old; Ramzi Al Arida; and Muhammad Abu Sari.
NABLUS	 Flying Checkpoint: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the settlement of Yizhar and detained hundreds of vehicles and civilians for several hours. Raids: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided Balata refugee camp and arrested 5 civilians, including 1 officer. At 02:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Furik and arrested 2

QALQILYA	 Separation Wall Gates: Passage through the separation wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Raid: At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqiliya and took position in the western and southern neighbourhoods. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested 2 youths in the village of Falamya near the separation wall.
SALFIT	• Raid: At 19:00, the Israeli army, including 1 military personnel carrier and 2 jeeps, raided the town of Kafr ad Dik, fired sound bombs and opened fire, injuring 1 civilian.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure</u>: The Erez crossing was partially open to workers over 35 years old. <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: 3 Qassam mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
GAZA CITY	 <u>Closure</u>: The junction of Nitsareem remains closed. <u>Land Levelling</u>: At 11:35, Israeli bulldozers levelled land south of the city of Gaza near Al Shuhada' junction.
CENTRAL GAZA	Raid: At 20:30, Israeli troops raided the area of Wadi Al Salqa, south of Deir Al Balah.
KHAN YUNIS	 Closures: (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road (Al Tuffah checkpoint) was open to pedestrians only. (iv) Abu Holi road was partially open.

	• <u>Attack</u> : At 22:20, the Israeli army opened fire from its location at Point 9 towards civilian houses in West Khan Yunis refugee camp.
RAFAH	 Closure: The Gaza International Airport remains closed. Land Levelling: At 06:30, the Israeli army levelled land near the neighbourhood of Al Barazil. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Musa Al Jallad, a Palestinian officer, at the Rafah border crossing.
