(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access

	<p>Jerusalem city.</p> <p>(ii) Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Qaddu. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Yabaad, clashed with residents then withdrew at 21:40. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Faku’a village until 23:45. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Daif village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement.

The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raids:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces raided Marda village until 15:00. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 12:30, Palestinian and International peace activists marched in Kafr Al-Dik village to protest land confiscation and settlement activity; Israeli forces clashed with the protestors and caused several cases of suffocation from teargas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village access to the area. • Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up checkpoint near Al-Hafs area in southern Hebron. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at Zif village junction. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by launching several artillery shells from their positions behind the Green line towards North Gaza and Israeli naval vessels firing shells towards Central Gaza. • Israeli aircrafts launched missiles in 16 separate airstrikes towards North Gaza, Central Gaza and Rafah, killing 12 Palestinians and injuring 17 others, including a child and a woman. • Palestinian gunmen launched 140 projectiles towards the Green Line.

(ii) On the evening of March 9th 2012, Israeli forces fired several tank artillery shells towards agricultural land in Jabaliya. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Aerial Assault:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, an Israeli drone targeted a vehicle, assassinating the leader of an armed group and another man and critically injuring another man.
