WEST BANK

Closure:

- The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biidddu.
- **Raid:** At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp.

Attack:

- (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya Airport fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 13:55, Israeli forces positioned in Dahiyat Al-Bareed neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in Sur Bahar village detained two children: Mohammad Jadallah (15 years old) and Mohammad Bassit (16 vears old).
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces detained Ashraf Hussein in Jerusalem.
- Temporary Detention: On March 11th 2015, Israeli forces temporarily detained five Women: Hanan Abu Sneineh, Iman Abu Sneineh, Fatima Oumani, Sahar Al-Natsheh and Zuheir Eid then released them after imposing financial penalties and prevented them from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 15 days.

	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	• Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500
	dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.
	• Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli array continues to close the mode of Til Parin and Pait Family
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

NABLUS	(ii) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Tel village, clashed with several residents, occupied a home and converted its rooftop into a military post and temporarily detained its resident inside a room then stormed another home and withdrew vat 02:45.
	• <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 residents: Mohammad Saleem, Raslan Azmi and Bassam Hani as they were paving a road in Tabi'a area then released them after confiscated their agricultural tractor.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city
SALFIT	to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.
	(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

• <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic until 11:30.					
• Raid: At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya village until 03:10.					
 Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:20 and again at 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho At 00:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 01:05. Raid: At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Jericho. At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, fired stun grenades as they stormed and searched several homes, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli intelligence officers then withdrew at 03:00. At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqba camp, clashed with several residents and summoned two residents: Khaled Bataja and Tawfiq Qandil to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:05. 					
 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3nd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. 					
(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.					

Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- Attack: At 00:40, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces stormed Kisan area located in south Taqou' and levelled 40 dunumes (Acres) of agricultural land owned by Jabarin and Obiyat families then withdrew at 14:30.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Wadi Qabun located in North Hebron.
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Einun village.
- (iii) At 08:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya.
- (iv)At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron.
- (v) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabu Yunis area junction (located along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron) until 19:30.

• Raid:

- (i) At 05:45 on March 11th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Thariya and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Dura until 12:30.
- (iii)At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a vehicle spare parts shop then withdrew at 03:30.

• Detention:

- (i) At 01:00 on March 11 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Aziz Abu Sneneh and Majdi Abu Sneineh, confiscated a computer and several cellular telephones from Hussien Abu Snienehs home.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaldoun Al-Tal and Nayef Jabarin
- **Temporary Detention:** At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint located

along Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Abed Al-
Salameh then released him at 00:10.

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Attack: On the morning of March 12 th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Beit Lahiya and as a result damaged two fishing boats.
KHAN YUNIS	• <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of March 11 th 2015, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers stormed 100m into the vicinity of Al-Khaz'aa and fire as they levelled a plot of land.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students and businesspersons. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
