JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continue to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 05:00 on March 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained a resident. (ii) At dawn on March 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Baba area located in east Al-Eizariya and demolished a home owned by Imad Al-Jahalin and

	<p>demolished a den used as a car wash owned by Sami Abu Aliya for allegedly being built without licence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Asslan in Qalandiya camp. (ii) Israeli forces detained Midhat Al-Eisawi in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on March 12th 2014 and again at 03:50 on March 13th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained 2 residents, stormed several homes and detained an additional 3 residents {5 total detained}. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 5 residents: Mohammad Al-Tel, Mohammad Al-Natour, Ahamd Al-Sharif, Malik Al-Arshiya and Biullal Zied during their raid into A-Jalazun camp • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at the bypass road near Beitin village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents returning from the home of Saji {who was killed by Israeli forces}. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Turat Al-Sharqiya until 16:00. (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed a home and an apartment building, detained 2 residents, confiscated a computer from Khaled Al-Jajj's home, temporarily detained Dr. Mohammad Al-Sayed then released him after questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Salem" Military prison detained Mohammad Basalat as he was visiting his detained brother. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Al-Haj and Mahmoud Al-Atrash in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Baqa Al-Sharqiya. (ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Nur Al-Shams camp in Tulkarem, stormed several homes, detained 6 residents then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Abdallah Jaber, Saed Arraf, Ahmad Dabour, Nasser Abu Sarris, Arrif Abu Salim and Rabi’ Shihadeh in Nur Al-Shams camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at between Azzun and Kafr Thulth. (ii) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and

	<p>impeded the free flow of traffic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village as they escorted several Israeli settlers who stormed archeological sites in the area then withdrew at 16:00. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hatab village until 19:15. (iii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and stormed a home.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Harris village, temporarily detained 3 residents: Eyad TahaIbrahim Saleh and Bassam Daoud then released them at 18:00. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Yassuf village until 23:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Iskaka village {for alleged shooting incident at a bus carrying Israeli settler}, stormed the home of Samir Al-Umi (head of the village council), confiscated a computer and inspected surveillance footage then withdrew at 02:10. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Al-Oja. (ii) At 18:50 and again at 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Marj Al-Naj'a village, stormed 4 homes then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and

(ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Obidiya until 15:25. (iii) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Khadr until 17:00. (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 01:00. • <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of March 12th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashaydeh village, stormed several homes and detained 2 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Othman Attil and Billal Attil in Al-Rashaydeh village • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On March 12th 2014, Israeli forces temporarily detained Nawal Obiyat, a resident of Bethlehem as she was visiting her husband in an Israeli prison. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

HEBRON

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
 - **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Zif village junction.
 - (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrance of Sa'ir and Al-Fuwar camp junction.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on March 12th 2014, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed several homes detained a resident, and summoned 4 residents: Samer Al-Sha'rawi, Amjad Al-Sharawi, , Oday Hisham and Nizar Hisham to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Halhul.
 - (iii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Tarama village, stormed the Department of Transportation and Vehicle registration and inspected documents of several documents.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Huwar junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 15:50, Israeli force positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in the funeral of a resident near the local Cemetery and as a result injured 5 residents including 3 children: Bashir Abu Ayash (16 years old) and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) On March 12th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near "Kiryat Arba" settlement in the old city of Hebron detained Hassan Dariya (15 years old), a resident of Bethlehem.
 - (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Eyad Rashad near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron.
 - (iii) At 12:45, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Burqan (15 years old) near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Masalmeh in Dura.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On March 12th 2014, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im, served halt to construction orders on 3 homes owned by Ibrahim Al-Tira, Ibrahim Hassan Al-Tireh and Suliman Al-Tireh for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in Area C which is under Israeli military and Administrative control. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah. • Israeli fighter Jets and Drones broke the ceasefire agreement by launching missiles towards North Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah. • Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 140 projectiles towards the Green Line.

<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of March 12th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line launched tank artillery shells towards agricultural land in Beir Hanun and Beit Lahiya. • <u>Air Assault:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, Israeli drones launched a missile towards Palestinian gunmen in Beit Hanun. (ii) On the evening of March 12th 2014, Israeli drones launched a missile towards Palestinian gunmen in Beit Lahiya.
