JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on March 12th 2013, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mus'ab Abd Rabbo and Ahmad Eliyan in Sur Bahar village. (ii) At dawn on March 12th 2013, Israeli force detained 2 residents: Ali Jadallah (17 years old) and Musa Dubrus in Al-Isawiya. (iii) At 18:00 on March 12th 2013, Israeli forces detained Munir Salah Al-Din at Hizma village junction.

	<p>(iv) At dawn on March 14th 2013, Israeli forces assaulted and detained Yazan Siyam after storming his home in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</p> <p>(v) At dawn on March 14th 2013, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Rizq and Adel Najib after storming their homes in the old city of Jerusalem.</p> <p>(vi) At dawn on March 14th 2013, Israeli forces assaulted Eyad Al-Shalabi after storming his home in Al-Suwana neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstrations:</u> On March 13th 2013, a demonstration took place near the municipal building in occupied Jerusalem protesting against the Israeli authority's decision to pave road (4) on land in Beit Safafa village in order to connect 2 Israeli settlements with Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Dibwan and detained. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Berih, Ramallah and Beituniya cities until 05:00. (ii) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Turmus'aya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli detained Ahmad Sanabil in Deir Dibwan. (ii) Israeli forces detained Habib Al-Hindi in Turmus'aya. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 12:00, a demonstration took place in Ramallah in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad. (ii) At dawn on March 14th 2013, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed a home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 12th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at a flying checkpoint detained Jihad Shalabi (a University student) as he was returning home near Silat Al-Hartha. (ii) Israeli forces detained Amar Samara in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

	for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area. • Raid: At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Bardala and served demolition orders for a fish farm pond owned by Jihad Sawafta and Ashraf Sawafta.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the road connecting Wadi Al-Tin and East Tulkarem. • Wall Gates: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up checkpoints at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement. (ii) On January 17th 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area. (iii) On February 6th 2013, Israeli military bulldozers levelled residential land in Jayyus for the purpose of Wall construction.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction and detained a National Security officer. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, detained a resident, and confiscated a computer and a cellular telephone. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Salem village and clashed with its residents then withdrew at 22:30. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with its residents they stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Daghlas near Shave Shomron settlement junction. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hillal Hanini in Beit Furiq. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of March 13th 2013, Israeli forces positioned near south Nablus fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and left 5 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Between Harris and Kafil Harris. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village near the north entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 in Al-Oja village • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Ashraf Doufish, a resident of Hebron as he was on his way to travel to Jordan and prevented him from leaving. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:25, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</p> <p>(v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat</p>

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:00 on March 13th 2013, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 07:30 on March 14th 2013, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya
