<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On March 3<sup>th</sup> 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> <li>(iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions near Al-Za’im checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hizma village junction.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 14:30, Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during their raid into Al-Bawaba village {which was established by several local and International Peace Activist on land under threat of Israeli military confiscation in Al-Eizariya} for alleged stoning and detained two residents.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli force detained Arribat Mohammad and Hussein Badr during their raid into Al-Bawaba village {which was established by several local and International Peace Activist on land under threat of Israeli military confiscation in Al-Eizariya}.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jerusalem and assaulted three residents including two children: Majd Abu Shamsiyah (15 years old), Ahmad Abu Shamissya (13 years old) {Bothe residents of Silwan} and Ahmad Abu Ta’a (A resident of Beit Hanina).</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>RAMALLAH &amp; AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’aal village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed a building then withdrew at 03:50.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a child: Maher Ghawanmeh (17 years old), Ahmad Abdel-Al and Hamzah Al-Natour.</li> <li>(ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces positioned near Ofar Military Base/ Prison opened fire towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Thaer Abu Laban and Ra’fat Abu Shaqra {after being struck by a tear gas grenade in the face} and as a result, left them hospitalised.</li> <li>(iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad, fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Mohammad Hammad (12 years old), Mohammad Abu Thariya (17 years old) and Abdel-Hay Hammad.</li> <li>(iv) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 08:55, Israeli settlers positioned on land located in Jabarah area located between Turmus’aya and Khirbet Abu Falah village then withdrew at 09:50.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result injured Lo’ia Al-Tamim (gun shoot wound to his leg) and assaulted and injured the child : Farah Al-Tamimi (15 years old) and left Bushra Al-Tamimi suffocated from tear gas inhalation and detained a residents then temporarily detained an International peace activist.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Bushra Al-Tamimi during demonstrations in Al-Nabi Saleh village.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, summoned 2 residents: Ameer Khalid and Nour Bayda to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstration:</u></b> At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured 6 residents  including 2 children: Ahmad Da’as (13 years old), Araf Ali (16 years old), Layth Mustafa, Moa’yad Ishtewi, Mahmoud Barham and Murad Ishtewi and also left several demonstrators suffocating form tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> </ul>

Until 23:05.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Husan village stormed a Tailor shop and a civil service office, inspected surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 16:00.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Nis village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:15.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning; temporarily detained Akram Abu Diya (9 years old) then released him after coordination with The Palestinian Security Force.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstration:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:10, a demonstration took place near Kissan village protesting against land confiscation for settlement construction purposes during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstration then assaulted Hani Fanoun (A journalist) and prevented him from recording the demonstration and temporarily detained Hassan Barajjiya then released him at a later time.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’sra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance Beit Ainun village until 12:40.
- **Raid:** At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron and summoned Rami Al-Ju'bah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:20.
- **Detention:** At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Sham'iyah" settlement located in south area of Al-Samou' detained Yusef Aqel.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Settler Violence:** At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Suwissa" settlement located in south east Yatta assaulted and injured Hani Dababsah.

<p><b>NORTHERN GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Point:</b> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, allowed 198 residents from the Gaza strip for prayer in Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem businesspersons, and passengers travelling abroad and through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> On the morning of March 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area located in west Beit Lahiya.</li> </ul>
