JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 14th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned in Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of

<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed Al-Makakma checkpoint located near Bet El in North of Al-Bireh then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction and detained a child. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, summoned 3 residents: Ahmad Wahbi, Khalil Abu Hathiya and Baha Wahbi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Atara Bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired Stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beitin fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Hamad (17 years old) and Mohammad Yusef Hammad and detained a resident. (iii) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Abboud fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces positioned neat Al-Tayba junction detained Ata Ka'abneh (17 years old). (ii) Israeli forces detained Khalid Rahim in Beitin. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 12:45, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin village protesting against the construction of the wall, clashed with Israeli forces, injured an International Peace Activist and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of T'inik village, temporarily detained 3 residents and released them at a later time

	<p>then withdrew at 16:45.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jenin until 20:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 13:45, Israeli forces raided the industrial zone in Jenin. • Attack: At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jamal area in south Jenin fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, temporarily detained 2 residents: Ammar Salameh and Awni Saleem then released them at 15:30. • Raid: At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village and stormed a home. • Demonstration: At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators and as a result injured 4 residents: Raed Ishtawi, Omran Ali, Billal Jum’a and Qassir Qaddum after being struck with tear gas grenade canisters and left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the

<p>NABLUS</p>	<p>village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:35, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint detained Khalid Hamdan, a resident of Nablus. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli force positioned at “Barja” settlement junction located in south Nablus fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including a child: Mohammad Nassar (15 years old), Yusef Al-Khatib, Oday Sahatari and also suffocated Taher Halbouni (15 years old) from tear gas inhalation.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Istiya. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit and positioned in front of National Security force headquarters then withdrew at 18:15. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village until 10:10. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned at “Malle Ofrim” checkpoint temporarily detained Mohammad Bani Fadil then released him at a later time.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel”

	<p>settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Betar village until 11:35. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Abiyat area located in east Bethlehem until 13:35. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 00:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'assra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site. (ii) At 14:50, a demonstration took place in Carmisan area located in North West Beit Jallah protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of constructing the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa'

- towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou’ village with cement blocks.
 - (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to “Haji” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 15: 00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Al-Tabaqa village junction until 15:50.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces raided Jurat Salem area in Ithna until 13:10.
 - (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 23:10.
 - (iii)At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Dura and summoned Musa Issa to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:00
 - (iv)At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Bani Na’im, stormed several homes, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 07:00.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Ahmad Abu Ayash (16 years old) {Critically injured} and Mohammad AAl-Za’iq and during which Israeli forces occupied a home owned by Mohammad Awad and converted its rooftop into a military post..
 - (ii) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces detained: Mohammad Abu Sneneh (15 years old) in the old city of Hebron.
 - (ii) At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Hebron detained Mo’yad Al-Tal.
 - (iii)Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mahmoud Barakat, Ehab Hajouj and Ismail Khadour in Bani Na’im.
 - **Home Occupation:** At 15:00, Israeli forces occupied a home owned by Imad Abu Shamaseh and converted its rooftop into a military post in Tel Al-Rumatyda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line
