<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikka village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Al-Rababah area in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on March 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, stormed several homes and detained three children. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat checkpoint detained Ammar Abdel-Jawwad. (ii) At dawn on March 16th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained three children: Bakr Owies (16 years old), Wael Salameh (16 years old) and Nur Ghazal (16 years old). (iii) Israeli forces detained three children: Kareem Mustafa (15 years old), Yusef Mustafa (16 years old) and Shaker Mustafa (16 years old) in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqsa mosque gate temporarily detained 4 women including 3 minors: Anhar Al-Ajouli (12 years old), Aya Zaghal (12 years old), Aya Abu Nab (16 years old) and Randa Abu Sneieneh then released them after imposing a financial penalty approximately 500 NIS and banned them from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem for a period of 15 days. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settler under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning, temporarily detained Abdel-Rahman Ali (14 years old) then withdrew at 18:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Rimawi and Adham Al-Asmar in Beit Rima.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Zabdah and Ya’bad until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on March 15th 2015, Israeli forces raided Jalboun village, stormed and searched a home and detained a resident after confiscating his IPAD and a cellular telephone. (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, temporarily detained the child: Hammam Abu Bakr (16 years old) and released him later then withdrew at 12:20. (iii) At 04:35, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed two homes, and detained two residents including a National Security Force officer then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nathmi El-wani and Zakariya Azouqa in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tayassir village and Al-Tha’ra area located in east Tubas then withdrew at 02:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid until 09:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ras and Kafar Sur villages until 16:50.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural

	<p>road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:50, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 20:15. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Jayyus, stormed five homes then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Tel and Iraq Burin village junctions until 17:00. (ii) At 17:15, Israeli force set up a checkpoint along a bypass road leading to Tel village, temporarily detained 2 residents: Nur Amashneh and Royihan Hammad for allegedly carrying a sharp object then released them later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Qaryout village and detained three residents. (ii) At dawn on March 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Zuwata village and detained a resident. (iii) At dawn on March 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Iba and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Hussein Marawdeh, Harrih Allan and Thaeer Marawdeh in Qaryout village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mi'ari in Zuwata village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Abu Bader in Beit Iba. • <u>Attack:</u> On the afternoon of March 15th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Qaryout village fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in Olive tree planting event on residential land under threat of Israeli Military confiscation and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Murda village, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:20. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara junction detained Mohammad Raslan. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Khufash in Marda village.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village in North Jericho. (ii) At 18:20 and again at 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 00:30.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

	<p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00 and again at 12:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction (located at the south entrance of Bethlehem until 14:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarat village, stormed a home summoned Islam Salem to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:20. (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed several homes summoned Ayad Taqatqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Urub camp until 09:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed several homes, detained two residents after searching their homes then withdrew at 05:45. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, detained three residents after storming and searching their homes. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Ayash (A resident of Beit Ummar) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mahmoud Al-Rajoub and Alaa Al-Rojub in Dura. (iii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Ta'miya, Mohammad Fayeze Abdallah and Mohammad Zaki Abdallah • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 13:00, The Israeli Minister of Foreign Affairs: Avghidor Lieberma and several members of his Political Party stormed Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and thus prevented residents from conducting afternoon prayers in the mosque then withdrew at 14:20.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza and Rafah.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, and NGO staff, allowed 198 residents from the Gaza strip for prayer in Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem businesspersons, and passengers travelling abroad and through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Detention: On March 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident he attempted to climb the border fence into Israel.
<p>CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the morning of March 16th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers on agricultural land located in east Al-Maghazi camp and east Deir Al-Balah.
<p>KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: On the morning of March 16th 2015, Israeli forces detained two unidentified residents as they attempted to climb the border fence into Israel.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. • Attack: At dawn on March 16th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Karam Abu Mu'amar area located in north east Rafah.
