• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continue to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces detained 6 residents including 3 children and an elderly resident: Adaya Al-Sidawi (50 years old), Abdlallah Hadad (15 years old), Mohammad Bojeh (17 years old), Ahmad Jabr (17 years old),, Ziyad Abu Hadwan and Saed Assilah.

• Attack:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators' participation in "Book Day" march.
- <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On March 16th 2014, the Israeli Minister of Public works and Housing approved plans for the construction of a settlement near "Ramot" settlement located in North Jerusalem on Palestinian land occupied in 1967.

• Assault on Places of Worship:

(i) At 06:30 on the morning of March 16th 2014, Israeli settlers under the

	protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades and as a result injured 4 residents and prevented residents under the age of 40 from entering Al-Aqsa Mosque. (ii) At 08:30, Israeli settlers accompanying the Israeli Minister of Public Works and Housing stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked several worshipers.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.

- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 22:00.
- (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' until 02:15.

• **Raid:**

- (i) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 02:15.
- (ii) At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:55.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1^{st} 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in South Hebron.

- Raid: At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 12:55.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Fida Nassar(A Journalist) as she was working on a report documenting Israeli settlers holidays then released her at 16:00.

• Attack:

- (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii)At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents towards several resident participating in a funeral for alleged stoning.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah
