	Closure: (i) Since January 13 th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to
	the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and BeitIksa villages.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	• Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in Kafr Laqef village north
	of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement;
	and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement because of Sabbath
	holiday.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-
	Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the

	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two
	detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to
	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years,
	and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of
SALFIT	traffic.
	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Zaatara checkpoint
	and impede the free flow of traffic.
	• Flying Checkpoints: At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of

	because of the Sabbath holiday.
	• <u>Closure</u> :
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq
	Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition
	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables
	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the
	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied
	them.
	• <u>Closure of Main Roads</u> : (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-

- Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town because of the Sabbath holiday.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement as tanks fired shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza. Israeli naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Gaza

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanoun (Erez) is closed. Attack: At 20:00 and again at 06:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in Beit Lahia.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Central Gaza	• Attack: On the evening of March 17 th 2012, Israeli forces fired tank shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Al-Bureij refugee camp.
