**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge and at the entrance of Al-Thahiriya.
  - (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Hahul Bridge.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Karza village and positioned in front of Palestinian Police headquarters then withdrew at 13:20.
  - (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- **Temporary Detention:**
  - (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces temporarily detained three children: Azam Da'nah (12 years old), Billal Al-Rajabi (12 years old) and Jallal Abu Ghazaleh (12 years old) in the old city of Hebron then released them at 15:30.
  - (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained four residents: Suliman Al-Athrah, Wael Abu Tabikh, Ahmad Abu Tabikh and Bader Al-Shawahin near Al-Manazil village which is located in east Beit Ummar then released hem at 24:00.
- **Physical Assault:** At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron assaulted Bara' Al-Madhoun (16 years old) and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions.
