JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) Since January 13th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem City. Detention: On 18.03.2012, Israeli forces detained Mohammed Smom 15 years a resident of Silwan. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second *Intifada*, (ii) the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to **QALQILYA** Kafr Qaddum village. Flying checkpoints: At 18:20, at Jet village junction. (i) Raid: (i) At 19:00, at Kafer Qaddum village and searched 2 homes. Between 02:10 - 03:25, at Azzun town, searched 2 homes and detained 2 (ii) neonle. At 02:10, at Qalqilia city. (iii) (i) The detained in Azzun town are: Qusai Salem (17 years) and Moawia Salim. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. **Checkpoints:** Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on (i) Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and, 02:00 **NABLUS** At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to (ii) cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. At 09:20, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Shave Shomron (iii) checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:15. **Flying Checkpoint:** Between 12:50 – 13:20, at Burga village junction. (i) Between 13:50 - 15:00, at Beit Imrin village junction. (ii) At 15:40, at Al-Maslakh junction (the entrance of eastern areas in Nablus (iii) City). (iv) Between 18:05 – 19:20, at Beit Furik town. - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.
- (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Tagou' with dirt mounds.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) Between 18:35 and 19:10, at the entrance of Janata town.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 12:00, at Al-Samou town and detained 2 people.
- (ii) At 22:00, at Talaat Abu Hadid in the old city of Hebron and temporary detained 3 civilian police.

Raids:

- (i) At 09:10, at Yatta town and setup a checkpoint in the center of town.
- (ii) Between 11:30 and 14:00, at Hebron city.
- (iii) At 02:00, at Arroub refugee camp.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) The detained in Al-Samou town are: Ahmad Khalaf and Hamza Khalaf.
- (ii) In Al-Arroub refugee camp is: Nader Al-Jundi
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:45, a group of Israeli settlers in the Old City of Hebron, assaulted several people (under the pretext of throwing a Molotov), Mustafa Abu Sineineh sustained injuries from the settler attack, Israeli forces raided homes and temporary detained the residents.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

Hebron

GAZA STRIP

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13.03.2012 at 01:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza.
