JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, continue to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hizma.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> On March 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem detained Samer Abu Eisheh as he was participating in a rally in support of Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Darwish in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 06:30, Israeli forces demolished a barracks owned by Badwan Salaymeh in Wadi Al-Dam area in Beit Hanina .{After Israeli forces demolished his 270 m² home as mentioned in May 30th 2013 Report } • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On March 18th 2014, the Israeli Authorities order the implementation of the final phase of tunnel digging in Wadi Al-Hilwhe area in Silwan which is 100m south of Al-Aqsa mosque compound which consist of 6 dunumes and 20 m² of land for the construction of a settlement named “Qadumim Center” and will consist of 7 floors. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 11:30. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh, impeded the free flow of traffic as several Israeli settlers blocked the road then withdrew at 17:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit until 10:00. (ii) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Zababdeh and Masalmeh village until 15:05. (iii) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along The Arab-American University of Jenin junction until 13:15. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 13:40. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Tubas and opened fire then withdrew at 23:55.
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:20 on March 18th 2014, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 08:35. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli force raided Far’oun village stormed until 13:30. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem until 03:10. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:40, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Detention: At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Falamyia village detained 3 residents: Eyad Shamasneh, Issam Khaled and Abdallah Khaled. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction until 17:30. (ii) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction until 12:50. (iii) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 17:20. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 17:25, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka village bridge until 11:10. (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Salfit until 12:00. • Raid: At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:30. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Matariya in Salfit. • Temporary Detention: At 14:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Abdel-Hafith Samara (14 years old), a resident of Bruqin as he was herding his goats near "Arial" settlement then released him at 19:00. • Settler Violence: At 24:00, Israeli forces stormed Kafil Harris village and conducted Talmudic rituals then withdrew at 00:50. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with

(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 20:45. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Hussan village until 22:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Hussan village (for alleged stoning of an Israeli settler vehicle) and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jamal Hamarat in Hamarat village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' assaulted Nur Al-Din Tama'reh leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Taqou' opened fire, fired rubber coated steel bullets and fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Sabah. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2013, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces installed a steel gate at the entrance of Beit Anun village and left it open.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 11:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel entrance gate then reopened it at 12:30.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im until 02:00.
 - (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:50.
 - (iii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Surif village, searched a home then withdrew at 02:40.
 - (iv) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Dura , stormed several homes and detained 2 residents.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At dawn on March 18th 2014, Israeli forces detained Isam Abu Asheyeh (17 years old) in Hebron (In addition to those mentioned in the previous report).
 - (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Rida Gayth.
 - (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Mu'tasim Al-Muhtasib and confiscated his motorcycle.
 - (iv) Israeli forces detained Qussay Nassar in Hebron.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Mustafa Al-Munawara and Faqer Abu Ras in Dura.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Tabaqa junction rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Masim Al-Shahatit (16 years old) and released him at 14:25.
 - (ii) On the morning of March 19th 2014, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Al-Ramadin village opened fire towards a child as he was attempting to cross the wall to enter Israel for work and as a result killed him.
 - **Killing:** Israeli forces killed Yusef Al-Shawamra (16 years old) after opening fire towards him near the wall gate in Al-Ramadin village.
 - **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
