JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 21st 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) On the evening of March 22nd 2014, Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed Silwan neighbourhood and as a result injured several residents leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 17:30, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem protesting against Israeli killing of 3 residents during their raid into Jenin camp (as mentioned in the previous report) during Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and detained 6 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of March 21st 2014, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Zaghoul, a resident of Bethlehem, for allegedly entering Jerusalem

	<p>without a valid permit.</p> <p>(ii) Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Nassar Qus, Alaa Hadad, Ahmad Al-Ghoul, Ahmad Hadib, Nizar Sab Al-Laban and Oday Sab Al-Laban in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • Closure of Checkpoint: At 17:30, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint near "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh, impeded the free flow of traffic at then reopened it at 06:00 • Demonstrations: At 17:30, a demonstration took place near Al-Mahakma checkpoint near "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh protesting against Israeli killing of 3 residents during their raid into Jenin (as mentioned in the previous report) during which Israeli forces closed the checkpoint. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Arraba, clashed with residents as they stormed the home of ex-detainee Khadr Adnan. (ii) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, summoned 8 residents: Haytham Hushiyeh, Adel Ja'bari, Haytham Samara, Taher Aref, Mohammad Abu Obied, Hassan Zayed, Bara Abu Obied and Anas Hushiyeh then withdrew at 02:10. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Lid junction until 21:55. (ii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages until 22:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusun. (ii) At 05:35, Israeli forces raided Kafr Zeid village until 08:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 20:20. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village, fired rubber coated steel bullets ,stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohammad Ishtawi after being struck by a tear gas grenades canister on his leg and suffocated 2 children: Ahmad Jum’a (5 years old) and Tariq Ishtawi (9 years old) from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 23:35, Israeli forces fired flash and stun grenades towards residents in the area between Jit and Immatin villages. • <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces stormed Jit village and confiscated a bulldozer and a steam roller as construction workers were paving a road in the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.

<p>NABLUS</p>	<p>Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40 and again at 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 20:25. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 20:25. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of March 22nd 2014, Israeli forces raided Awarta village and detained 2 children. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Huwara, fired flash grenades in the area between Huwara and Burin then withdrew at 22:55. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:20, Israeli forces detained Jarir Mahmoud, a resident of Beit Wazan as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Qawariq (17 years old) and Sameh Awad (17 years old) in Awarta. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint temporarily detained Osama Matar, a resident of Ramallah then released him at 15:40.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafil Harris and Harris villages until 20:50. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harris village until 21:10. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za’tara checkpoint temporarily detained a Dubai News Television crew then released them at 16:50. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nuw’meh village.

	<p>(ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 18:25.</p> <p>(iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction in North Jericho until 22:15.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settler Violence: At 14:25, several armed Israeli settlers stormed Al-Sad area in Al-Oja village and placed a wire fence around a plot of land then withdrew at a later time.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Wadi Fuqin village until 11:35. (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Fajjar until 16:45. • Attack: At 15:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several homes and residents for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated an infant from tear gas inhalation and temporarily detained 3 journalists including a US citizen: Musa Al-Sahaer, Abdel Rahman Mansour and Danny then released them at a later time then at 00:35 clashed with several residents until 01:40

(ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun. (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta and stormed a home. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed several homes, detained residents and summoned 5 residents: Mohammad Al-Hamouni, Eyad Al-Hamouni, Amar Ghayth., Bilal Abu Sneh, and Tariq Al-Saghir to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:10. (iii) At dawn on March 23rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed home and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Samer Al-Talbishi in Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hamza Saleh in Dura.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by launching tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Rafah. and as a result injured 2 residents in North Gaza (As mentioned in the previous report). • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza .

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> At 10:00 on March 20th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya • <u>Injury:</u> On the afternoon of March 21st 2014, 3 residents: Mahmoud Abu Foul (16 years old), Nadal Nassef and Firas Al-Bis were injured after Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards them as they were on their agricultural land near the border fence in Jabaliya.
