<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Hazim Al-Sharabati and Hamza Milhis in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Rajab Imteir (A resident of Qalandiya Camp). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al-Foqa village and stormed a local school then withdrew at 15:00. (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Turmu’aya and clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:30. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Ni’lin, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 00:30. • Killing: At 17:00, Ali Mahmoud Safi (A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp) died of critical injuries sustained after being shot by Israeli forces during clashes in Al-Jalazoun camp as mentioned in the March 19th 2015 report. • Attack: At 1800, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, stormed and searched five homes and an Internet Café and summoned four residents: Hani Abu Al-Hassan, Obayda Abu Al-Hassan, Ra’fat Khamisah and Mohammad Farihat to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • Detention: At 05:00 on March 25th 2015, Israeli forces detained Anas Al-Damkh during their raid into Jenin. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Bal’a until 22:20. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces raided the area between Allar and Attil, stormed and searched a vehicle repair shop then withdrew at 00:30. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Alla Anbus during their raid into Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement

	<p>with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Kafr Qaddum, detained two residents, detained several others and released them after interrogation by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 18:30. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces raided immatin village, stormed and searched a home, a coffee shop and a carpentry shop then withdrew at 17:25. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:15, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Bassam Awafah, Mohammad Abu Aliwat (A resident of Tulkarem) and Rashid Al-Dik (A resident of Falamiya village) and temporarily detained Sa'ed Khader (A resident of Tulkarem) then released him after assaulting him (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Mahmoud Athnaabi and his wife near Kafer Qaddum. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces temporarily detained Baha Ghannam (A resident of Immatin) then released him at 19:15. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in West Qalqiliya fired stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:35, Israeli forces raided Huwarah, stormed several merchant shops, surveyed surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Qusra village, served seven military orders for the demolition of stock dens and water wells owned by: Ibrahim Wadi, Thaer Hassan, Mahmoud Odeh, Tariq Hassan, Saed Wadi, Mustafa Wadi and Ahmad Hassan. (iii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Burin village, set up two checkpoints, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 23:05. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Qabalan until 01:45. (v) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village, stormed and searched 3 homes then withdrew at 04:35

	<p>(vi) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed and searched five homes then withdrew at 04:35.</p> <p>(vii) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, stormed and searched three homes then withdrew at 04:05.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned in the east area of Deir Al-Hatab fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Shafiq Omar (17 years old) then released him at 21:40.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 21:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:30.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:20 and again at 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:30.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

	<p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village then withdrew at 10:50. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Husan village and stormed and searched a local mosque. (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhiesheh camp in Bethlehem, summoned two residents: Ra'fat Abu Aker and Khaled Khalawi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:25, Israeli forces positioned in Bidaar area located in Al-Khader temporarily detained four engineers from the Palestinian Ministry of Agriculture: Abdel-Rizq Muhsien, Fadi Al-Ja'bari, Yusef Salah and Thaer Omar then released them at 17:25. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:25, an Israeli settler opened fire along raid (60) in Al-Khader towards several children for alleged stoning.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and road #35 and a road leading to east Yatta and the road between Al-Safa and Al-Dirat villages as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron and stormed and searched several homes.
 - (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 03:55.
 - (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed several homes, detained two children then withdrew at 04:20.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Nabeel Masalmeh, Loai Masalmeh and Fadi Masalmeh in Beit Awwa.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Sahrif (15 years old) and Khaled Al-Sharif (14 years old) in Al-Urub camp.
- **Temporary Detention:**
 - (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained two children: Mahmoud Abbaddin (13 years old) and Sa'id Salhab (10 years old) in the old city of Hebron then released them later.
 - (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Mohammad Madi (12 years old) then released him at 16:00.
- **Attack:** At 08:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessel broke the ceasefire agreements by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: At dawn on March 26th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: On the morning of March 26th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Jaher Al-Dik located in south east Gaza city.
<p>RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
