<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 05:40 on March 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and detained three residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on March 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Halmoush (17 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood. (ii) At 05:00 on March 26th 2015, Israeli forces detained three Children: Ahmad Sharabati (16 years old), Mohammad Boujah (16 years old) and Khaled Mulhis (16 years old) in Al-Tur and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhoods. (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Islam Assaf, Abdel-Rahman Al-Zir and Abdel-Rahman Hammad in Qalandiya Camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained the child Yassmin Ayoub (16 years old) then released her later. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jaderrah village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged

	<p>stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents including a child: Ahmad Zied (17 years old), Amar Sawalha, Ali Muzahim and Muhanad Darraj as well as assaulting Linda Shalash (a journalist).

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village until 23:35. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Attil, clashed with several residents, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 21:30. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Far'oun village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 21:30.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern

	<p>entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Immatin and Al-Funduq village. (iii) At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Izbat Salman and Ras Attiyah village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Azzun village until 22:30. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. (iii) At 19:00. Israeli forces closed the wall gate in Jayyus and temporarily detained several residents trapped on the other side of the wall gate until reopening it at 21:10.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:35 on March 26th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq and stormed two homes. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Madma village, stormed three homes then withdrew at 01:10. (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village, stormed three homes then withdrew at 03:45. (iv) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, an armed Israeli settler stormed the area near "Yitsahar"

	<p>settlement and attacked a chicken farm owned by Yaser Odeh (A resident of Madma village) and threatened Bader Odeh at gunpoint and forcibly removed them from the area and withdrew later.</p> <p>(ii) At 10:25, a group of Israeli settlers temporarily abducted three Sheppard's: Mu'taz Hamad, Ribhi Bani Jame'n and Jawdat Jaber then released them at 11:00.</p> <p>(iii) At 10:50, Israeli settlers positioned near "Yitsahar" settlement opened fire towards several residents.</p> <p>(iv) At 03:25, a group of Israeli settlers driving 4 vehicles stormed Josephs Tomb in Nablus then withdrew after encountering Palestinian Police forces in the area.</p> <p>(v) At 06:30, Israeli settlers stormed "Al-Tawahin Park" in Al-Bithan village then withdrew 07:20.</p>
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: At 08:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:00. • Temporary Detention: At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned near Kafr Al-Dik temporarily detained four residents: Ayman Ali, Abdallah Ahmad, Iz-Al-Din Ahmad and Abdel-Rahim Ahmad then released them later. • Settler Violence: At 16:30, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Kafr Al-Dik stoned several residents and vehicles then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 23:20.

(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 18:45. • Raid: At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Jericho. • Temporary Detention: At 10:15, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Osama Mansour as he was returning from Jordan then released him later.

<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Beit Fajjar until 13:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Jinata. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces detained Ghazal Amin (15 years old) in the old city of Hebron. (iii) At 12:55, Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Huhtasib after assaulting him in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 08:45, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Juhar area in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained two children: Abdel-Karim Al-Ajlouni (11 years old) and Mohammad Al-Ajlouni (11 years old) then released them later. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On March 25th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Jinata and Al-Fakhit villages located in south east Yatta and served military orders for the demolition of three residential dens owned by: Mohammad Hushiyeh, Isam Maghamrah and Ali Jabarin. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 04:00 on March 26th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Deir Musa area located near Surif and served military orders to halt construction of six homes owned by: Ali Musa, Issa Ghanimat, Zahir Ghanimat, Mohammad Safi, Yusef Salamah and Musa Ghanimat. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Shalashleh road in the old city of Hebron stoned residents and vehicles passing along the road.
