WEST BANK

Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Oalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and **JERUSALEM** another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. Flying Checkpoint: At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shu'fat camp. Raid: At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and summoned Imad Al-Barghouthi (A University Lecturer) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Shu'fat camp detained Omran Joud (A resident of Shu'fat camp). (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Salah Sandouka and Haytham Hijazi in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Hindi (A resident of Jadeerat village) as he was farming his agricultural land near the wall. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate (ii) on Al-Shavyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. **Flying Checkpoint: RAMALLAH &** (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi AL BIREH Saleh village, temporarily seized a vehicle carrying Dr. Layla Ghannam (The Governor of Al-Bireh and Ramallah District) and temporarily detained her Office Manager then released him at a later time during which confrontations erupted between Israeli forces and demonstrators

	and Israeli forces temporarily detained Jamil Al-Barghouthi then released him at a later time and assaulted Ali Awawdeh then withdrew at 16:30.
	(ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Turmus'aya junction until 23:40.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- Raid: At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 04:10.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 17:35, Israeli forces detained four residents: Mahmoud Shushah, Tarik Hamarah, Mohamamd Hamarah and Ahmad Zghloul as they attempted to cross into Israel.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrances of Beit Ummar and Beit Onin village until 10:00.
- (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at Halhoul Bridge and the entrance of Beit Enuon.
- (iii)At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Tal'at Abu Hadid area in the old city of Hebron.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Hebron, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 05:35.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Surif then stormed and searched a home.
- (iii)At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Dura, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:15.
- (iv)At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched several homes and summoned the child: Qusay Abu Mariya to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ali Al-Awawi and Hazim Al-Himouni in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ammar Qazzaz in Dura.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 13:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Karma'il" settlement which is located in east Yatta temporarily abducted Jaber Hathalin and his son as well as seizing their herd of sheep then released them later.
- (ii) At 22:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-Shiyoukh and uprooted 1200 Olive trees owned by Mohammad Abu Adiya, Abdel-Qadder Al-Adiya and Musa Al-Adiya.
- (iii)At 11:15, a group of Israeli settlers stoned Mohammad Jaber and his son as they were farming their agricultural land in Beit Ummar.

HEBRON

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli Forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.

GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	• Attack: On the morning of March 29 th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards farmers on agricultural land in east Deir Al-Balah.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
