JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continued to close the entrances to al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</li> <li><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al-Bareed to the town of al-Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li><b>Raids:</b> The Israeli army raided the village of Beit Anan and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li><b>Arrests:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On March 30, the Israeli army arrested at Ramot checkpoint civilian Ali Mahmoud Jaber Shamasneh while he was trying to enter Jerusalem without a permit.</li> <li>On March 30, the Israeli army arrested in the village of Sur Baher civilian Thaer Ali Ahmad Atoun.</li> <li>The civilian arrested in the village of Beit Anan is Qassem Mahmoud Abu Nasser.</li> </ol> </li> <li><b>Wall Gates:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at al-Hamra checkpoint set up along al-Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-‘Auja along al-Mu’arrajat road that connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> </ul>

The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> At 17:40, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the junction of al-Nashash (southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 20:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Asakreh, searched 1 civilian house, and handed 1 civilian a notification to report to the Israeli military intelligence.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem. The raid recurred at 02:00.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assaults:</u></b> At 21:55, the Israeli troops positioned at Kfar Etzyon checkpoint attacked civilian Nasim Yasser who was taken to hospital for treatment.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> On March 30, a public march set out in the village of al-Ma’sara in memory of Land Day and in protest of the apartheid wall</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>HEBRON</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al-Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. ## PRISONERS' CONDITIONS

- The Israeli military court at Salim detention camp extended the administrative detention of the following 13 prisoners from Jenin and Tulkarem districts: Sameer Jamil Amro & Rasim Khuzaymah until 29 March; Ahmad Ziyad Nazzal, Mohammad Khaled Sabaghneh & Mohammad Sa'id Abu al-Rab until 19 May; Mohammad Zeidan al-Gada' until 20 May; Mohammad Anwar Abu al-Rab, Mohammad Hassan milhem, Ra'ed Sa'ed Adam, % Rami Mohammad Abed until 27 May; Talal Salah Eddin Abu Na'im until 29 May; Iyad Abdel Latif Abu al-Rab until 3 June.
- The Israeli military court in Salim detention camp sentenced prisoner Wassim Abu Ghalui to 7 months term and a fine of 200 shekels equivalent to 20 dollars; prisoner Suhayb Hanani to an 11 months term and a fine of 1000 shekels equivalent to 280 dollars; prisoner Mohammad Sami Miri for a 14 months term and a fine of 1000 shekels equivalent to 280 dollars; prisoner Maher Awad to a 10 months term and a fine of 2000 shekels equivalent to 570 dollars; prisoner Iyad Hashash to a 32 months term and a fine of 2000 shekels equivalent to 570 dollars; prisoner Mutaz al-Taher to an 11 months term and a fine of 1000 equivalent to 280 dollars; prisoner Radwan Sweidan to a 6 years term; prisoner Jihad Qamhiyyeh to an 84 months term The Israeli court also put off the trial of 50 prisoners and incriminated 10 prisoners.
