#### WEST BANK **Closure:** Since January 13<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at (i) checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints: JERUSALEM** Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border (i) crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Israeli forces continue to close the entrance to the Shofat refugee camp (ii) with cement blocks, which will impede the free flow of traffic in Ras Khamis, Ras Shihadeh and Salam neighbourhood in Anata and Shofat refugee camp in Jerusalem. Attacks: At 16:00, Israeli forces fired teargas and stun grenades at the entrances of Eissawyia village and Shufat. **Injuries:** At 15:50, Israeli military vehicle ran over Bilal Abu Hawa (17 years) in Al-Tur neighbourhood. **Demonstration:** At 11:00, a demonstration took place at Qalandia checkpoint commemorating (i) Land Day; Israeli forces clashed with protestors, injuring 22 people, several with teargas inhalation. (Including minors and 8 paramedics), damaging 3 ambulances and detaining 3 people. At 13:30, a demonstration took place at Damascus gate in the Old City; Israeli (ii) forces clashed with protestors, physically assaulting 2 journalists and

	temporarily detaining 2 people: Hatem Abed Al-Qadder and Jaber Muheisin.
	• Wall Gates:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on
	Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-
	Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs
	to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of
	Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of
	the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
	• Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to
	Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'EinSamiya villages.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 10:00, at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village; forces
	detained 1 minor and temporarily detained 4 people among, including a security
	officer.
	• <b>Detention:</b> The detained in Al-Nabi Saleh: Abed Rimawi (16 years).

	road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
	• Raids: At 18:10, Israeli forces raided Zabbuna village); Israeli forces clashed with

	• Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted
	special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services
	for civilians living behind the Wall.

QALQILYA	<ul> <li>Closure of Roads: <ol> <li>Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun</li> <li>In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to KafrQaddum village.</li> <li>Raid: <ol> <li>At 15:20 and repeated at 22:00, Kafer Qaddum village.</li> <li>At 16:00, at Hijja village.</li> <li>At 16:05, at Qalqilia, temporary detained 2 people: Mahmoud and his brother Majed Fayed.</li> <li>At 23:20, Azzun town.</li> <li>Demonstrations: At 13:20, Palestinian and international peace activists commemorating "Land Day" marched in Kafer Qaddum village to protest closures of the entrance gate leading to the village; Israeli forces fired teargas and stun grenades towards demonstrators as they approached the village entrance, injuring 3 people, including Odai Aqel with contusions, while several other demonstrators suffered suffocation from teargas.</li> <li>Wall Gates: <ol> <li>The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.</li> </ol> </li> </ol></li></ol></li></ul>
NABLUS	Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and BeitFurik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	• Checkpoints:
	(i) At 05:00Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays.  All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
	(ii) At 19:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Shave Shomron checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	• Flying checkpoints:
	(i) Between 12:00 – 13:50, at Qabalan town junction
	(ii) At 13:10, at Iraq Burin village junction.
	(iii) At 17:40, at Madama village junction.
	• Raid: Between 23:55 – and 00:15, Israeli forces raided Einabous village.
	• <u>Demonstration</u> : At 14:00, a demonstration took place commemorating Land Day at Iraq Burin village; a confrontation took place between the demonstrators and the Israeli forces, injuring 4 people and several cases of suffocation from teargas inhalation.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two
	detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to
	Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	• Flying checkpoint: At 09:30, at Al-Zbeidat village junction.

	• <u>Harassment of Security forces:</u> At 15:40, Israeli forces temporarily detained a police car and the policemen at Al-Hamra checkpoint.
	• <u>Demonstration</u> : At 13:00, a demonstration took place commemorating Land Day and against the construction of the Israeli wall and settlements.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22*dunums* of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in BeitSahur and Bethlehem cities.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of BeitFajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.
- (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10<sup>th</sup> 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Tagou with dirt mounds.
- <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to impose restrictions at the Container checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) Between 10:00 15:10, at the Western entrance of Tagou town.
- (ii) At 10:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 11:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched at the vicinity of Bilal Bin Rabah mosque to commemorate Land Day and to protest against the construction of the wall; Israeli forces fired teargas grenades towards the protesters, leaving 2 demonstrators injured with contusions. The injured are Yousef Arafa and Tony Bright.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village access to the area.
- Flying Checkpoints: Between 13:00 and 16:00 at Halhoul town bridge.

#### • Raids:

- Between 08:50 and 11:30, at Hebron city.
- Between 13:40 and 21:00, at Beit Ummar town and occupied the rooftop of Fawzi Abu Ayash's home.
- At 16:50, at Dura town.

### Hebron

- At 18:40, at Tabqa village, a confrontation took place between the residents and Israeli forces.
- <u>Attacks:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces fired teargas towards the residents of Beit Idwan village.

#### • Demonstrations:

- (i) At 12:20, Palestinians marched in commemoration of Land Day at Zif and Khursa junctions, the entrance of Al-Aroub refugee camp and the Old City of Hebron.
- (ii) At 13:00, Palestinians marched in commemoration of Land Day at the entrance of Beit Ummar town; Israeli forces fired teargas and stun grenades towards the protestors, resulting in 4 injuries.
- (iii) At 13:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched in Tel Al-Rumeideh neighbourhood in Hebron's Old City to protest against settlement expansion and demanded that Al-Shuhada road be reopened (it was closed in 1994).
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
