JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on March 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and detained 3 residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a child. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On March 30th 2014, Israeli forces detained Khalid Al-Husseini in Jerusalem. (ii) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Wahib Obied, Mohammad Obeid and Mufid Obied in Al-Isawiya. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ali Qara’in (14 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At dawn on March 30th 2014, Israeli forces temporarily detained and assaulted 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Tariyaqi and Ahmad Abu Farha after storming Al-Sa'adiya neighbourhood then released them at a later time. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On March 30th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Haradoun area in Jabal Al-Zaytoun neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished Mohammad Al-Muslimani's 100 m residential barracks for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of March 30th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem (in commemoration of International Land Day), calling for the establishment of a Palestinian and the end of Israeli occupation, during which Israeli forces assaulted the demonstrators and suffocated Ilham Nu'man after spraying her with pepper spray. (ii) At 14:25, a demonstration took place near Qalandiya checkpoint (in commemoration of International Land Day) during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud village bridge until 13:30. (ii) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabrud village bridge until 17:20. • <u>Attack:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

	<p>western entrance of Ya'bad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jenin in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ein Al-Bayda village until 19:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Ein Al-Bayda village, temporarily detained 3 residents: Maher Fuqaha, Omar Abed and Ehab Fuqaha then released them at 21:10.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus temporarily detained Ahmad Talib (A National Security Forces officer), a resident of Tulkarem. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:05, a demonstration took place in Tulkarem (in commemoration of International Land Day), calling for the establishment of a Palestinian, the end of Israeli occupation, freedom of access to agricultural land during which they Planted Olive trees in agricultural land were Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, injured Bassam Al-Jirmy and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Azzun and Izbit Al-Tabib village. (ii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jinsafut village junction. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Elisa's village. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Azzun, forced several shop owners to close down their business then withdrew at 00:35. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:45, Israeli settlers positioned near Jit village junction opened fire towards Nidal Shihadeh, a resident of Nablus as he was fixing replacing a flat tire on his vehicle and as a result left him hospitalised with gunshot wounds. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate

The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 11:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:00. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed a building then withdrew at 04:20. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned near Tel village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several farmers as they were farming their agricultural land. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces positioned near Osirin village junction, opened fire and launched tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • Settler Violence: At 00:40, Israeli settlers stormed Taflit and Qaryut villages set fire to agricultural land and as a result destroyed 7 Olive trees.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya until 08:30. (ii) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Bidya and Sanniriya village until 09:10. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya

(ii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) junction near Al-Nui’emeh village and temporally seized 4 vehicles carrying Palestine Television news and Camera crew then released them at 17:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces raided “Bawabat Al-Qarameh” village which was established by several local and International peace activist near Al-Jiftlik village, forcibly removed demonstrators from the area and detained 6 demonstrators including a Palestinian Police officer. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 6 residents: Ayman Bani Odeh (a Palestinian Police officer), Billal Bani Odeh, Akram Qa’dan, Mohammad Bashirat, Salah Al-Taya and Diya’ Bani Odeh.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of

	<p>Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:40, the Israeli military intensified their restrictions at Container checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabah village until 16:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 01:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On the afternoon of March 30th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint temporarily detained 2 residents: Munthir Amireh and Mahmoud Zuhurat then released them at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Ahmad Radi (14 years old) then released him at 19:00. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:00, a demonstration took place in Bethlehem(in commemoration of International Land Day), calling for the establishment of a Palestinian , the end of Israeli occupation during which Israeli forces prevented demonstrators from passing Al-Nashash junction (the south entrance of Bethlehem) in order to reach agricultural land under threat of Israeli confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

“Haji” settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Samou’.
 - (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
 - (iii) At 00:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge, opened fire towards a vehicle for allegedly hurling a fire bomb towards Israeli troops at the checkpoint then withdrew at 03:50.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on March 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and stormed a home.
 - (ii) On March 30th 2014, Israeli forces raided Tarusa village and detained a resident.
 - (iii) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Halhul.
 - (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Arqoub in Tarusa village.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 17:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tabaqa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Sadeq Abu Maria (17 years old) and Kamel Abu Maria after being assaulted by Israeli forces leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **Settler Violence:** At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Faqasis village and planted several Olive trees in an attempt to confiscate the land then withdrew at 16:00.
- **Demonstrations:**
 - (i) At 14:00, a demonstration took place in Beit Ummar (in commemoration of International Land Day), calling for the establishment of a Palestinian, the end of Israeli occupation and freedom of farmer access to their agricultural land during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result injured the child Qayse Abu Mariya (12 years old) and left 6 others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
 - (ii) On March 30th 2014, a demonstration took place in Al-Ras area located near “Kiryat Arba” settlement in east Hebron (in commemoration of International Land Day), calling for the establishment of a Palestinian, the end of Israeli occupation, against continued settler violence against residents and agricultural land and against the Israeli court decisions to grant ownership of a Palestinian home to Israeli settlers.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.
