JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (iii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Anata junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jadeerah village and stormed two homes. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Duqqu village and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur and Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained three residents: Tariq Al-Shoubaqi, Fathi Nasser and Khalil Qulayeb. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Qatanin (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem detained Alaa Al-Joulani. (iii) At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem detained three residents including a child: Khaled Al-Bassat (16 years old), Ayman Al-Bassat and Bassim Al-Bassat. At 21:50, Israeli Forces positioned Thouri fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents on the pretext of stone throwing. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the morning of March 31st 2015, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Jouz neighbourhood and demolished a section of a home consisting of a room and storage area approximately 80 m² as well as a concrete fence and several surrounding trees owned by Amour Family for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On March 30th 2015, Israeli authorities approved plans for the construction of 142 settlement Unites (three Apartment buildings consisting of 48 apartments in one and 509 apartments in the other two buildings) in "Har Homa" settlement located in south Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Ofar" Military base fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Rawan Al-Arraj (A resident of Beituniya) then released her later.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raids:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Turat Al-Sharqiya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdallah Qubha during their raid into Turat Al-Sharqiya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 21:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 00:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:25. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdel-Min'em Zaghdad in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of wall gate (104) located in West Tulkarem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several University students participating in "Land Day" protest and as a result injured Abdel-Hakeem Shahin (A resident of Nablus).
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 13:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Muntar area located in West Jayyus fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 10:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Burin village and occupied the rooftops of several homes and a school in the village then withdrew at 11:10. (iv) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Huwarah, stormed a supermarket and confiscated surveillance video footage and detained a resident. (v) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, stormed several homes, detained three residents then withdrew at 03:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:25, Israeli forces detained Nash’at Al-Anani (A resident of Nablus) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Karaam Ameer in Huwarah. (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ali Al-Shuli, Alaa Al-Shuli and Qays Jawabrah in Assirah Al-Shimaliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned along the main road in Huwarah fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in “Land Day” protests and as a result left 15 residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 14:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic temporarily as they seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through later. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Kafr Al-Dik until 16:30. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem) and detained aa resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem) detained Rami Abu Nar (A resident of Aqbat Al-Jaber camp in Jericho).

(v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Al-Thahriya until 12:15. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Surif and Al-Jab'a village and detained two residents of Beit Ummar. <p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching stun and tear gas grenades from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis and as a result injured three residents in Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

(ii) At 12:20 on March 28th 2015, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards several residents on agricultural land in near Al-Shuhad'a cemetery located in east Jabaliya. (iii) At 19:00 on March 29th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach located in west Beit Lahiya.
