WEST BANK **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and BeitIksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access **JERUSALEM** Jerusalem city. The Israeli military set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shu'fat refugee (ii) camp in Jerusalem replacing the old checkpoint placed at the entrance of the camp which will close off and separate Shu'fat RasKhamis, RasShihadeh, Al Salam neighbourhood, Anata and Shu'fat camp from Jerusalem Raid: (i) At 16:55, the Israeli forces raided and patrolled al-Ram town. (ii) At 24:00, the Israeli forces raided Qalandia refugee camp and clashed with civilian during house raid injuring 4. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu (i) Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on (ii) Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Nave Shomron settlement junction and searched civilians and vehicles until 10:45.
- (ii) At 09:20, the Israeli forces set up a flying near DeirSharaf junction. The checkpoint was set up again at 22:00 and the Israeli forces searched civilians and vehicles until 22:30.
- (iii) At 14:55 and 16:35, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Surra village junction and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 16:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Yitzhar settlement junction and searched civilians and vehicles.

• Raids:

- (i) At 01:40, the Israeli forces raided Nablus city and arrested 2 civilians. In addition, the Israeli forces handed over a summon to 1 civilian to report to the Israeli military intelligence and withdrew at 02:30.
- (ii) At 01:45, the Israeli forces raided Bourin village, stormed several houses and arrested 9 civilians, including 1 child, and then withdrew at 03:50.

• Arrests:

- (i) The 2 civilians arrested in Nablus city are (1) Adel Fakhouri and (2) Abdelhamid Ashour.
- (ii) The 9 civilians arrested in Bourin village are (1) GhalebNajjar, (2) Bilal Omar,

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
- (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 08:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

- (i) At 10:40, the Israeli forces raided Khirbet Qais village and patrolled it unti 11:00

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) Since 12:45 on 28 December 2011, the Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to a public school in Sweisiya village located in East Yatta with dirt mounds.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:00, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Hanineh area in Dura town. The checkpoint was set up again at 17:20 and the Israeli forces searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 17:20, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on the junction of Al-Tabaqa and Kharsa villages.
- Raids: At 24:00, the Israeli forces raided Al-Fawwar refugee camp, stormed several Civilian homes and arrested 1 civilian.
 - Arrests: The civilian arrested in Al-Fawwar refugee camp is Jamal RaghebSalmi.
 - **Provocation of Palestinian Forces**: At 18:30, the Israeli forces detained a Palestinian Civilian Policevehicles in the Old city of Hebron.
 - <u>Demolition of Property:</u> At 01:25, the Israeli forces demolished part of a gas station under construction in Beit 'Ummar town.
 - <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. This is in breach of the agreement in this regard with the Israeli side, which specified the limit of territorial waters at 20 nautical; Israel had unilaterally changed this agreement first in October 2006, when it shrunk the area to 6 nautical miles, then in January 2009, when it declared the limit at 3 nautical miles. The Israeli forces breached ceasefire and opened fire at Khan Younis and fired two missiles.

NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critically ill patients, Journalists, NGO staff, merchants and travellers travelling to Al Karama with previous coordination. Palestinian Attacks: On the eve of 30 April 2012 Palestinian militia fired a missile at the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attacks: On the eve of 30 April 2012 the Israeli forces fired 2 missiles at agricultural land in Jabal Al-Rayes area east of Gaza city.
KHAN YOUNIS	Raids: In the morning of 01 may 2012, the Israeli forces raided east of Al-Qararatoen and razed land.
	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for critically ill patients, students and residents with special permits Sufa Crossing is closed.
RAFAH	• Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transportation of food supplies, goods, humanitarian aid cooking gas, and 19 trucks and 30 truckloads of wheat.
