- (ix) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
    - (i) At 07:40 on April 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, at 11:20 and again at 18:10 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge until 18:30.
    - (ii) At 12:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Khlat area in the old city of Hebron until 13:00.
    - (iii) At 16:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ta'at Al-Taqrouri area in the old city of Hebron until 17:30.
    - (iv) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta and Al-Samou' until 18:15
  - **Raid:**
    - (i) At 11:10 and again at 02:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 04:00.
    - (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, stormed 6 homes then withdrew at 01:00.
    - (iii) At 07:30, Israeli force raided Ithna and stormed a home.
  - **Detention:**
    - (i) At 01:10 on April 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Tumayzi (A university student) as they stormed his home in Ithna.
    - (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces detained Khalid Hashash in the old city of Hebron.
    - (iii) At 18:50, Israeli forces detained Saddam Abu Sineneh in the old city of Hebron.
    - (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Zalat in Ithna.
  - **Attack:** At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ba Al-Zawiya area in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Ahmad Abu Ammer (12 years old).
  - **Home Demolition:**
    - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Shuyoukh Al-Urub village, demolished 2 homes (200 m) owned by Mohammad Abu Ghazai and Ahmad Abu Ghazi for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and administrative control during which Israeli bulldozers also uprooted several Olive trees and demolished a concrete fence surrounding the homes and Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards residents leaving them suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
    - (ii) On April 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Bakr in east Hebron , demolished a 110 m home owned by Mohammad Al-Rajabi for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and administrative control
  - **Demonstration:** At 10:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
