- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading between Bani Na'im and Zif village to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillageaccess to the area.
- (v) Since 17:20 on April 16th 2012, Israeli military closed the entrance to Qalqis village located in southern Hebron with dirt mounds.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge.

- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
