WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On April 24th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba' village iunction until 21:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, summoned Ribhi Abu Zied to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning until 05:15.
- (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents.

• Attack:

- (i) At 15:55, , Israeli forces positioned near Ras Kabsah area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained 2 residents including a child.
- (ii) At 16:55, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) On the evening of May 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained a child.
- (iv) On the evening of May 1st 2015, Israeli forces positioned Al-Tur neighbourhood fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ayad (17 years old) and Suliman Arrabiya in Abu Dis.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohanad Al-Sharabati (16 years old) in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood.

	mounds.
	(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with
	dirt mounds.

(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 13:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Aqbat Hassnah area located in Husan village, temporarily detained Shadi Hajjajrah (A National Security Force Officer) then released him later and summoned Mohammad Hajjajrah to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village.
- (iii) At 18:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Taqou' until 18:20.
- (iv) At 18:55, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tarah until 20:15.

• Raid:

- (i) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Husan village until 19:00.
- (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, summoned Issa Salah to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:25.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 17:35, Israeli forces positioned near the west entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sra village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 1400, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge.

• Raid:

- (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 13:30.
- (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp and summoned Islam Al-Titi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.

HEBRON

• <u>Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron detained the child: Awni Abu Shamsiya
(16 years old) and temporarily detained the child: Nizar Salhab (14 years old) then
released him later.

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom ALL of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will **DISTRICTS** be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces positioned behind the Green line broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Rafah. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **NORTHERN GAZA** (i) At 08:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. **GAZA** (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions. **<u>Detention</u>**: At 05:00, Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident as he was **KHAN YUNIS** attempting to cross the border fence from east Khan Yunis into Israel. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. **RAFAH** (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
