JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Rm junction until 01:20. • <u>Raids:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home, detailed a resident, confiscated a computer and cellular telephone then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hassan Shihadeh in Abu Dis. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of

	<p>Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:05 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho until 11:30. (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Liqya until 22:00. (iii) At 21:30 Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad. (ii) At 06:05, Israeli forces raided Beitin and summoned Mohammad Hammad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 17:00, a demonstration took place near Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near “Bet El” settlement in North Al-Bireh city protesting and calling for the freedom of access and movement for Palestinian Press and Journalists during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Dan village, confiscated an agricultural tractor owned by Imad Muslih, a resident of Burqin. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya, clashed with residents then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00. Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 23:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along AL-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 13:55. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>of Azzun town.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Elisa's village until 23:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:10 on May 3rd 2014, Israeli forces raided Kar Laqif, stormed a home and summoned Usayed Assaf to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army used bomb sniffing dogs to search residents and seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through at a later time. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madma village until 09:45. (ii) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Assira Al-Qibliya village until 12:00. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of May 1st 2014, Israeli forces raided Beita and detained a resident. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, stormed several homes, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 02:34. (iii) At dawn on May 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Madma village, stormed a home and detained a residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Muntassir Salah, Adham Abu Omar, Walid Abu Omar and Abdallah Salah in Burqa village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Moawiya Nassar in Madma village. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 02:40, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint assaulted Abdel Rahman Mohammad leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces prevented Aliya Ammar, a resident

	of Kafr Qalil from farming her agricultural land near “Baraghat” settlement for security purposes.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bruqin until 17:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:05, Israeli forces raided Harris village until 20:30. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with residents and as a result suffocated 5 residents including a Civil Defence officer from tear gas inhalation and damaged a vehicle owned by Nael Al-Hafath then withdrew at 01:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in north Jericho until 19:10 (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 21:10. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:00 on May 1st 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Haumra checkpoint detained Mohammad Bashirat, a resident of Tubas. • <u>Allenby Bridge</u> temporarily detained Sofa Hamathna; a resident of Nablus as she was returning from Jordan then released her at 16:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Asaqra village, stormed a home and summoned Ali Asaqra to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 00:20. (iv) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou's until 03:20. (v) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 06:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint temporarily detained Majed Hassasneh then released him at 19:05. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed agricultural land in Nihalin village, uprooted and damaged 54 Olive trees owned by Daoud Fanoun, Abdel Mutalib Fanoun., Na'im Fanoun and Taha Fanoun and sprayed Anti -Arab graffiti on I then withdrew at 11:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction halted in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (ii) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 12:30. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou’ until 22:00 (iii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Yatta, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Khaled Al-Haroush in Yatta. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:30, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land located between in Al-Thahriya and Al-Ramadin village then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces at 17:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza’s seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Khan Yunis and Rafah.
