JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 04.05.2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • Demonstration: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Palestinian activists marched in Qalandiya camp in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanded their release from Israeli jails during which they clashed with Israeli forces that fired teargas grenades injuring Baha Hamad (17 years), Wisam Nassar, Yusef Othman and several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:35, Palestinian activists marched in Abu Dis in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which they clashed with Israeli forces. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Raid: At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Silwad, clashed with residents and detained a child. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sara (16 years). • Settler Violence: At 00:10, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road north of Al-Bireh city. • Demonstration: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Al Nabi Saleh against the confiscation of the village’s land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators leaving with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators injured and several others suffocating as a result of tear gas inhalation.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 13:10, two demonstrations took place in Nilin town and Bilin village against the confiscation of the village's land; Israeli forces clashed with the demonstrators with Israeli forces leaving several of them suffocated from teargas inhalation. (iii) At 13:10, Palestinian activists marched in Ramallah in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. (iv) At 13:50, Palestinian activists marched near the entrance of Ofar prison in Beituniya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons and clashed with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Raids: (i) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Rumana village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. • Raid: At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Aqaba village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased restrictions on Palestinian access at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Demonstrations: At 13:40, family members of detainees and Palestinian activists marched in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib. (iv) At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint the entrance of Qalqilya. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village. (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Palestinian peace activists marched in Kafr Qaddum in protest against the continued closures during which Israeli forces raided the area and occupied the rooftop of Bakir Ali's home converting it into a military post. Israeli force then fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators leaving them suffocated as result of tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 17:00, Palestinian activists marched in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Qalqiliya in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karne Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement .
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 05:00 Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00 and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction until 10:45. (ii) At 10:35, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Madma village until 14:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Orif village and positioned near a police station then withdrew at 02:00. (ii) At 01:05, Israeli forces raided Burqa village, summoned Said Ewiays and Khalid Saleh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Asqar camp in Nablus. • <u>Detention:</u> On May 4th 2012, Israeli forces detained Kahlid Odeh (17 years). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:00, Israeli settler raided agricultural land in Iraq Burin.

<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Between 14:45 – 15:30, the Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on access at the Za'tara checkpoint and impedes the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raids:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed a home and summoned Ayman Nimer to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:55. • <u>Detention:</u> At 00:50, Israeli forces positioned at Zatarra checkpoint detained Wassim Marouf for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli settler's raided agricultural land in Rafat village then withdrew at 11:00 under the protection of Israeli forces. (ii) At 12:40, Israeli settlers raided Abu Zrik area in Salfit and surveyed land owned by Al-Zir family. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) Israeli forces continue restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik until 10:50. (ii) At 18:10 and again at 02:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. (iii) At 01:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction until 10:45. (ii) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the entrance of Biet Sahur. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Harmala and Al- Asakra villages until 19:30. (iii) At 20:50, Israeli forces raided Al –Ubidiya until 23:15. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:20, Israeli settlers raided Irtas village and set up tents on land owned Mohammad Khilawi then withdrew at 10:55 • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Palestinian activists marched in Al-Khadr in solidarity with detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which they clashed with Israeli forces leaving several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalations. (ii) At 13:20, Palestinian activists marched in Al-Ma’adsra in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzy Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (v) At 17:20 on 16.04.2012, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Kalkas village located near the Israeli DCO south of Hebron city. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatta. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tawarsa village. (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar. (iv) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ramadin village. (v) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Halhul Bridge. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli force raided Wadi Al-Joz area in Bani Na’im. (ii) At 09:20, Israeli force raided Qalqas village. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli force raided Dura until 10:15. (iv) At 12:10, Israeli force raided Deir Samit village, searched a barracks then withdrew at 12:30. (v) At 01:30, Israeli force raided Sara village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Attack:</u> At 14:05, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired tear gas grenades towards residents attending a funeral for alleged stoning and injured Ahmad Awad (14 years) and several others suffocating from tear gas inhalations then detained 2 children.• <u>Detention:</u><ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) At 13:15, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hazin at the entrance of Al-Urub camp.(ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Alami (15 years) and Nasir Al-Alamy in Beit Ummar.• <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Tal Rumeda in the old city of Hebron against the closure of the main road since 1994.• <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed
