WEST BANK

• Since 18:00 on May 4th 2014, Israeli military closed all crossing points of the West Bank in commemoration of the creation of The State of Israel and prevented residents including those with entry permits from Entering Jerusalem or Israel with the exception of International Diplomats, humanitarian cases and emergency health situations until 24:00 on May 6th 2014.

• Closure:

- Since 18:00 on May 5th 2014, The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city in commemoration of the creation of The State of Israel, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu.

• Raid:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 10:00 and again at 02:10, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents.

• Detention:

(i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained 4 residents including 2 children: Mohammad Karkour (17 years old), Mohammad Dala' (17 years old),

(iii) Israeli forces detained Walid Atiya in Al-Isawiya village. • Assault on Places of Worship: (i) At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces closed the main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents under the age of 50 years to enter. for prayers during which residents were forced to conduct afternoon, evening and dawn prayers on the streets outside the compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya
	west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
	Closure of Main Roads:
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Abi Mash'al village junction, temporarily detained the child: Rabah Barghouthi (17 years old and a Special needs patient) then released him at 20:25. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Flying Checkpoint: At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba junction until 17:15. Raid: At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, stormed 2 homes then withdrew at 18:25. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted
	special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services
	for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14; 45, Israeli forces positioned at Tayasir checkpoint, seized a Security force Ambulance and temporarily detained 2 Security force officers then released them at 15:05.

	 Assault on Property. At 12:55, Israeli forces served demolition orders for 7 homes and evicted its residents Ayad Zawahreh, Mariam Zawahreh, Ali Naji, Salem Naji, Khaled Faqir, Ali Faqir and Salameh Faqi from their homes in Al-Malah area located in the North Jordan valley and then until June 1st 2014 to leave their homes.
	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road
TULKAREM	 leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services
	for civilians living behind the Wall. • Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern
	entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Azzun (for alleged stoning of a settler vehicle), impeded the free flow of traffic and temporarily detained the child Osama Salameh (11 years old) and released him at a later time then proceeded to open the checkpoint. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of
QALQILIYA	Qalqiliya until 16:50. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the
	Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
	 Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
NABLUS	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Checkpoint: At 21:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:35.

	 Raid: At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Duma village and detained a resident. At 19:25, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with its resident, suffocated a resident from tear gas inhalation, detained a resident and temporarily detained (A Customs Police Officer) and released him at a later time and withdrew at 20:00. At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Osirin village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 22:00. Detention: At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Mash'al, a resident of Nablus as he was reporting to Intelligence officers based on a prior summon. Israeli forces detained Wajdi Salawdeh in Duma village. Israeli forces detained Muntaser Mansour in Burin village. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city
SALFIT	 (ii) Oil 13.04.2012, the Islaeli almy has opened the northern entrance to saint city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 21:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:45. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik until 17:15. • Detention: At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Ahmad Ibrahim, a resident of Jafr Ra'I village in Jenin. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village junction in North Jericho. At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 22:50. Temporary Detention: Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Majdoulin Hassoun, a resident of Nablus as she was returning from Jordan then released her at 22:35. At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned Allenby bridge temporarily detained Akram Al-Ayadi as he was returning from Jordan then released him at a later time.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) Since 22:50 on May 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Beit Fajjar with Dirt Mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On May 5th 2014, Israeli forces served demolition orders for several water wells owned by Hassan Salah for allegedly being built without a licence and gave him a period of 35 days to dispute the order.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

HEBRON

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along

- the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9^{th} 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Abu Sneneh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron
- (iii)At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul Bridge.
- **Raid:** At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:30.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli Naval Vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA

- Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed except for those entering from the Israeli side of the crossing.
- <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of May 6th 2014, Israeli Naval Vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in West Beit Lahiya.

GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
